- 1.0 NTPC Limited (NTPC) invites online bids on "Single Stage Two Envelope Bidding basis" from eligible bidders for aforesaid package, as per the scope of work briefly mentioned hereinafter.
- 2.0 NTPC intends to finance the subject package through Own Resources.

3.0 BRIEF SCOPE OF WORK

The scope of work includes supply and installation of Solar High Mast Lighting System (Green tower), at Project Affected Villages at NTPC-Mouda as per detailed technical Specification.

All bids must be accompanied by Bid Security Declaration. Bid Security Declaration shall be submitted by accepting the General Technical Evaluation (GTE) in Online Portal in accordance with ITB Clause 14.

In case a bidder does not accept the aforesaid declaration in GTE, then the bid shall be rejected by employer as being non-responsive and shall not be opened.

ANY BID NOT ACCOMPANIED BY AN ACCEPTABLE BID SECURITY DECLARATION/ TENDER FEE SHALL BE REJECTED BY THE EMPLOYER AS BEING NON-RESPONSIVE AND SHALL NOT BE OPENED.

5.0 ONLINE SUBMISSION OF EMD and TENDER FEE

The facility of submitting Tender fee through ONLINE MODE has been made available at Gepnic portal for NTPC. Bidders who wish to use this facility can avail the same in the e-procurement portal (Gepnic portal). Bidders availing this facility, are NOT required to submit documents of tender fee physically (hardcopy).

6.0 Benefits of MSE bidders in respect of Tender Fee, Bid Security and purchase preference are NOT applicable in this case.

7.0 QUALIFYING REQUIREMENTS FOR BIDDERS.

7.1 Technical Criteria:

The bidder who wishes to participate in the bidding shall meet the Qualifying Requirements stipulated hereunder:

7.1 **Technical Criteria:**

The bidders are required to fulfil the following:

The bidder should have successfully executed the work of "supply, erection and commissioning of 12 meters or higher size Solar light Mast(s) or solar street light(s)" within preceding 07 years as on the date of Techno-commercial bid opening in any of the following manner:

(a) Single Contract of value not less than Rs 47 Lakhs

OR

(b) Two Contracts of value not less than Rs 30 Lakhs each

OR

(c) Three Contracts of value not less than Rs 24 Lakhs each

Note:

- 1. The word "Executed" mentioned above means that the bidder should have achieved the criteria specified with any of the following conditions:
- **A.** Case –I: The work is started earlier (prior to the period stipulated in the clause 7.1 but completed within the stipulated period as mentioned in clause 7.1. In such cases, entire executed quantity of relevant work vide the work order shall be considered for evaluation.
- **B. Case-II:** The work is started and completed within stipulated period as mentioned in clause 7.1. In such cases, entire executed quantity of relevant work vide the workorder shall be considered for evaluation.
- **C. Case III:** The work is started within the stipulated period as mentioned in clause 7.1 but not completed as on the last date of stipulated period. In such cases, "In Progress"

executed quantity of the relevant work vide that work order as on the last date of stipulated period, shall be considered for evaluation.

- **2.** In case of orders under execution, the value of work executed till the date of Technocommercial bid opening duly certified by the owner shall be considered acceptable.
- **3.** Reference work executed by the bidder as a sub-contractor may also be considered provided the certificate issued by main contractor is duly certified by the owner specifying the scope of work executed by the sub-contractor in support of qualifying requirements.
- **4.** In case, bidder has executed reference work under two orders one for supply and one for services separately for the same installation, combined value of both the orders shall be considered as a single order for the purpose of evaluation.

7.2 Financial criteria:

- 7.2.1 The average annual turnover of the Bidder, should not be less than Rs 59 Lakh (Rupees Fifty Nine Lakh only) during the preceding three (3) completed financial years as on the date of Techno-commercial bid opening.
- 7.2.2 In case the bidder does not satisfy the financial criteria, stipulated at CI. 7.2.1above on its own, its holding company would be required to meet the stipulated turnover requirements at CI. 7.2.1 above, provided that the net worth of such holding company as on the last day of the preceding financial year is at least equal to or more than the paid-up share capital of the holding company. In such an event, the bidder would be required to furnish along with its Techno-Commercial bid, a Letter of Undertaking from the holding company, supported by Board Resolution, as per the format enclosed in the bid documents, pledging unconditional and irrevocable financial support for the execution of the Contract by the bidder in case of award.
- 7.2.3 In case the bidder is not able to furnish its audited financial statements on stand-alone entity basis, the unaudited unconsolidated financial statements of the bidder can be considered acceptable provided the bidder further furnishes the following documents for substantiation of its qualification.
 - Copies of the unaudited unconsolidated financial statements of the bidder along with copies of the audited consolidated financial statements of its Holding Company.
 - 2. A Certificate from the CEO/CFO of the Holding Company, as per the format enclosed in the bidding documents, stating that the unaudited unconsolidated financial statements form part of the Consolidated Annual Report of the company.
- 7.2.4 In cases where audited results for the last preceding financial year as on the date of techno-commercial bid opening are not available, the financial results certified by a practicing Chartered Accountant shall be considered acceptable. In case, Bidder is not able to submit the Certificate from practicing Chartered Accountant certifying its financial parameters, the audited results of three consecutive financial years preceding the last financial year shall be considered for evaluating the financial parameters. Further, a Certificate would be required from the CEO/CFO as per the format enclosed in the bidding documents stating that the Financial results of the Company are under audit as on the date of Techno-commercial bid opening and the Certificate from the practicing Chartered Accountant certifying the financial parameters is not available.

Notes for 7.2.1 above:

- 1. Other income shall not be considered for arriving at annual turnover.
- 2. "Holding Company" and "Subsidiary Company" shall have the meaning ascribed to them as per Companies Act of India, in vogue.
- 8.0 Any 'Bidder from a country which shares a land border with India', as specified in the Bidding Documents, will be eligible to bid in this tender only if bidder is registered with the Competent Authority as mentioned in the Bidding Documents.
- 9.0 NTPC reserves the right to reject any or all bids or cancel / withdraw the Invitation for Bids/NIT without assigning any reason whatsoever and in such case no bidder / intending bidder shall have any claim arising out of such action.
- 10.0 A complete set of Bidding Document may be downloaded by any interested Bidder from https://eprocurentpc.nic.in/nicgep/app. Tender fee as mentioned above in the is required to be submitted as stipulated in the bidding document before due date & time of submission of bid.

Prospective bidders are compulsorily required to provide GSTIN number with Tender Fee.

- 11.0 Issuance of bid documents to any Bidder shall not construe that such bidder is considered to be qualified. Bids shall be submitted online and opened at the address given below in the presence of Bidder's representatives who choose to attend the bid opening. Bidder shall furnish Cost of bidding document, Bid Security and Power of Attorney separately as stipulated in the bid document before the due bid submission closing date and time at the address given below.
- 12.0 Transfer of Bidding Documents purchased by one intending Bidder to another is not permissible.
- 13.0 'Class-I local suppliers' only are eligible to participate in this tender, as defined in the bidding documents/ Public Procurement (Preference to Make in India), Order 2017 and its subsequent amendments/ revisions issued by DPIIT. The bidders may apprise themselves of the relevant provisions of bidding documents in this regard before submission of their bids."

OR

'Class-I local suppliers' and 'Class-II local suppliers' only are eligible to participate in this tender, as defined in the bidding documents/ Public Procurement (Preference to Make in India), Order 2017 and its subsequent amendments/ revisions issued by DPIIT. The bidders may apprise themselves of the relevant provisions of bidding documents in this regard before submission of their bids."

OR

"Bids from 'Class-I local supplier' as defined in the bidding documents/ Public Procurement (Preference to Make in India), Order 2017 and its subsequent amendments/ revisions issued by DPIIT shall be eligible for purchase preference. The bidders may apprise themselves of the relevant provisions of bidding documents in this regard before submission of their bids."
