Note: "NTPC shall allow purchase preference, as indicated in the bidding documents, to bids from local suppliers as defined in the bidding documents. The bidders may apprise themselves of the relevant provisions of bidding documents in this regard before submission of their bids."

No Queries from Bidders, whatsoever, shall be entertained by the Employer beyond the last date of receipt of Queries/ Pre-Bid Conference (if applicable) as specified above.

Note: 1. Bid Security Declaration:

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Bidders are requested to give Bid Security Declaration by accepting the GTE.

By accepting the GTE-"Do you accept Bid Security Declaration" it will be considered that Bidder has read the provisions of the bidding document and they hereby declare the following:

a). We confirm that, in case we withdraw our offer within the validity period of the offer provided in the bidding documents or any extension thereof, then we shall be treated as ineligible for participation in the future tenders issued from NTPC for a period of 06monthsfrom the date of withdrawal of the bid.

b). In addition, we also confirm that in case after having been issued the Notification of Award/Purchase Order of a package, we either do not accept the Notification of Award/Purchase Order or do not sign the Contract or do not submit an acceptable Performance Security as per bidding documents provision, and which result in tender being annulled then we shall be treated ineligible for participation in retendering of this particular package and contractual action may be taken against us as per the provisions of the Bidding documents. Further, NTPC shall also be free to take further actions as per the provisions of the policy for Withholding and Banning of Business Dealings.

2. "Class-I local suppliers' only are eligible to participate in this tender, as defined in the **3** | P a g e



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bidding documents/ Public Procurement (Preference to Make in India), Order 2017 and its subsequent amendments/ revisions issued by DPIIT. The bidders may apprise themselves of the relevant provisions of bidding documents in this regard before submission of their bids."

NOTE:

Bidders are requested to give acceptance of meeting the MLC (Minimum Local Content) requirement by accepting the GTE & declaration as per Local_Content_Annexure-II.pdf.

By accepting the MLC provision of GTE it will be considered that:-

"Bidder is 'Class-I local supplier' and is meeting the MLC requirement stipulated in Annexure-1 to SCC.

Also supplier has not been debarred / banned by any other procuring entity for violation of 'Public Procurement (Preference to Make In India), Order 2017' (PPP-MII Order) dated 15.06.2017 and its subsequent revisions / amendments issued by Department for Promotion of Industry and Internal trade (DPIIT)''.

In case false declaration in respect of Local content, same shall be treated as false declaration and will be dealt in line with the Fraud Prevention Policy of NTPC.

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The bidders may apprise themselves of the relevant provisions of bidding documents in this regard before submission of their bids.

No Queries from Bidders, whatsoever, shall be entertained by the Employer beyond the last date of receipt of Queries/ Pre-Bid Conference (if applicable) as specified above.

3. Any 'Bidder from a country which shares a land border with India', as specified in the Bidding Documents, will be eligible to bid in this tender only if bidder is registered with the Competent Authority as mentioned in the Bidding Documents.

However, the said requirement of registration will not apply to bidders from those countries (even if sharing a land border with India) to which the Government of India has extended lines of credit or in which the Government of India is engaged in development projects.

- **4.** A complete set of Bidding Documents may be downloaded by any interested Bidder from our NIC Portal (https://eprocurentpc.nic.in/nicgep/app).
- **5.** Clarification on bidding documents:

A prospective Bidder requiring any clarification of the Bidding Document shall put the query under Clarification tab of the on-line bid at least three days prior to the clarification end date. EMPLOYER will respond to any request for clarification or modification of the bidding documents that it receives within the time line specified.



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EMPLOYER will post the Clarifications under Clarification/Corrigendum tab at e-tender website. Bidders can view these clarifications.

- 6. Transfer of Bidding Documents issued by one intending Bidder to another is not permissible.
- **7.** Qualifying requirement:

	The bidder should have executed the work(s) of "Operation & Maintenance OR
	Operation OR Maintenance of Heavy Earth Moving Machinery" in a thermal power plant
	or in coal mines, in the preceding seven (7) years prior to the date of techno commercial
	bid opening meeting the following criteria
	a) Single order of value not less than Rs 47.73 Lakhs.
	OR
	b) Two orders of value not less than Rs 29.83 Lakhs each



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OR c) Three orders of value not less than Rs 23.87 Lakhs each
Note: All values are exclusive of GST/other Taxes. Notes for Clause 1.0 above:
The word "executed" means the Bidder should have achieved the criteria specified in the qualifying requirements at Clause 1.0, even if the contract has been started earlier and/or is not completed/ closed and shall be considered as below.
Case-I: The work is started earlier prior to the period stipulated in Clause-1.0, but completed within the stipulated period as mentioned in clause 1.0. In such cases, entire executed value of the relevant work vide that work order shall be considered for evaluation
Case-II: The work is started and completed within the stipulated period as mentioned in clause 1.0
Case-III: The work is started within the stipulated period as mentioned in clause 1.0 but not completed as on the last date of stipulated period. In such cases, "In Progress" executed value of the relevant work vide that work order as on the last date of stipulated period, shall be considered for evaluation



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Remarks: Any of the above cases shall be supported by documentary evidence issued by the "Owner".

"Owner" means the entity which has the original requirement of the subject work and has initiated and awarded the work to the contractor (bidder) for executing the reference work against which the credentials have been submitted.

And the "Owner" defined as above is not a contractor to any other entity for the reference work. In case, the bidder has worked as approved sub-Contractor/sub-vendor, he has to provide documentary evidence issued by the "Owner".

2.0 Financial Criteria

The average annual turnover of the Bidder, in the preceding three (3) financial years as on the date of Techno-Commercial bid opening, should not be less than Rs 59.67 Lakhs (Rupees Fifty Nine Lakhs and Sixty Seven Thousands only).

Notes for Clause2.0 above:

(i) In case where audited results for the last financial year as on the date of techno commercial bid opening are not available, the financial results certified by a practicing Chartered Accountant



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shall be considered acceptable. In case, Bidder is not able to submit the certificate from practicing Chartered Accountant certifying its financial parameters, the audited results for the three consecutive financial years preceding the last financial year shall be considered for evaluating the financial parameters, a Certificate would be required from the CEO/CFO as per the format enclosed in the bidding documents stating that financial results of the company are under audit as on the date of techno-commercial bid opening and the certificate from a practicing chartered accountant certifying the financial parameters is not available.

(ii) Other income shall not be considered for arriving at annual turnover.

8. Issuance of Bidding Documents to any Bidder shall not construe that such Bidder is considered qualified.

9. Transfer of Bidding Documents purchased by one intending Bidder to another is not permissible.
