1.0 NTPC Limited invites online bids on Single Stage Two Envelope bidding basis (Envelope-1: Techno-Commercial Proposal & Envelope-2: Price Proposal) from eligible bidders for “*Procurement of complete assembly of fly ash pump at NTPC Kahalgaon*”, as per the scope of work briefly mentioned hereinafter.

As per provisions of bidding documents, the bidders shall submit “Techno-Commercial Proposal” and “Price Proposal” online (<https://eprocurementpc.nic.in/nicgep/app>), within the bid submission date and time as mentioned above. Only Techno-Commercial proposals will be opened on the date and time mentioned in the NTPC-GePNIC Website.

5.0 The date of opening of Price Proposal shall be intimated separately by NTPC after completion of evaluation of Techno-Commercial Proposal.

6.0 Tender Fee shall be paid separately online (by NEFT/RTGS) through GePNIC Portal. Micro and Small Enterprises (MSEs) registered with District Industries Centres or Khadi and Village Industries Commission or Khadi and Village Industries Board or Coir Board or National Small Industries Corporation(NSIC) or Directorate of Handicrafts and Handloom or Udyog Aadhar,UDYAM Certificate or any other body specified by Ministry of Micro, Small and Medium Enterprises as per MSMED Act 2006, for goods produced and services rendered, shall be issued the bid documents free of cost.

The above benefits to MSEs are meant for procurement of only goods produced and services rendered by MSEs. However, traders are excluded from the purview of Public Procurement Policy and not eligible for Benefits to MSEs. Also, benefits under Public Procurement Policy for MSEs shall not be extended in Works Contract.

Exemption Certificate towards Tender Fee and purchase preference for MSE's in line with Clause 4.0 of ITB along with the MSE Undertaking as per the format is to be uploaded in Fee Cover of Online Bid.

7.0 Earnest Money Deposit: In lieu of EMD, bidders are required to submit Bid Security Declaration as per format in **Annexure-II**. Bidders shall necessarily accept the following General Technical Evaluation (**GTE**) of the Tender without which Bidder cannot submit their Bid **"Do You Accept Bid Security Declaration"**.

8.0 NTPC shall allow purchase preference, as indicated in the bidding documents, to bids from local suppliers as defined in the bidding documents. The bidders may apprise themselves of the relevant provisions of bidding documents in this regard before submission of their bids.

9.0 A complete set of Bidding Documents may be downloaded by any interested Bidder at our E Tender Site (<https://eprocurementpc.nic.in/nicgep/app>). For logging on to the E Tender Site, the bidder would require to create user ID and Password as per the Bidder's Manual Kit provided in the aforementioned web site. The payment (non-refundable) of the cost of the documents as mentioned above in the form of a crossed account payee demand draft in favour of **NTPC Ltd.**, Payable at **BARH** shall be submitted in a sealed envelope separately offline by the stipulated bid submission closing date and time at the address given below.

#### 10.0 Qualifying Requirements:

##### **Technical Criteria:**

1.0 Bidder should be a manufacturer/ Indian Agent of any Foreign manufacturer of **"Ash Slurry Pumps with unit pump capacity not less than 1200 M3/hr."**, during last 07 (seven) years reckoned from date of Technical bid opening as per **any of the following criteria:**

(a) **One** executed work valuing not less than **Rs. 50.40 Lakh (INR Fifty Lakhs and Forty Thousands only)**

OR

(b) **Two** executed works, **each** valuing not less than **Rs. 31.50 Lakh (INR Thirtyone Lakhs and Fifty Thousands only)**

OR

(c) **Three** executed works, **each** valuing not less than **Rs. 25.20 Lakh (INR Twenty-five Lakhs and Twenty Thousands only)**

##### **Financial Criteria:**

2.0 The Average Annual financial Turnover (AATO) of the bidder during preceding three (03) consecutive Financial years prior to the date of techno-commercial bid opening should not be less than **Rs. 63.00 Lakhs (INR Sixty-three Lakhs only)**.

3.1 In case a bidder does not satisfy the financial criteria, stipulated above on its own, its Holding Company would be required to meet the stipulated turnover requirements as above, provided that the Net Worth of such Holding Company as on the last day of the preceding financial year is at least equal to or more than the paidup share capital of the Holding Company. In such an event, the Bidder would be requested to furnish along with its Techno-Commercial bid, a Letter of Undertaking from the Holding Company, supported by the Holding Company's Board Resolution, as per the format enclosed in the Bid Documents, pledging unconditional & irrevocable financial support for the execution of the Contract by the Bidder in case of award.

**3.2** In case the Bidder is not able to furnish its audited financial statements on stand-alone entity basis, the unaudited unconsolidated financial statements of the Bidder can be considered acceptable, provided the Bidder further furnishes the following documents for substantiation of its qualification.

i) Copies of the unaudited unconsolidated financial statements of the Bidder along with copies of the audited consolidated financial statements of its Holding Company.

ii) A Certificate from the CEO/CFO of the holding Company, as per the format enclosed in the bidding documents, stating that the unaudited unconsolidated financial statements form part of the Consolidated Annual financial statements of the Holding company.

**3.3** In cases where audited results for the last financial year as on the date of the Techno-Commercial Bid opening are not available, the financial results certified by a practicing Chartered Accountant shall be considered acceptable.

In case Bidder is not able to submit the certificate from practicing Chartered Accountant certifying its financial parameters, the audited results of three consecutive financial years preceding the last financial year shall be considered for evaluating the financial parameters.

Further, a Certificate would be required from the CEO/CFO as per the format enclosed in the bidding documents stating that the financial results of the Company are under audit as on the date of Techno-Commercial bid opening and the Certificate from the practicing Chartered Accountant certifying that financial parameters is not available.

**Clarificatory Notes for the Clauses above:**

**I.** The word “**Executed**” mentioned above means that the bidder should have achieved the criteria specified above within the preceding seven (07) years period, even if the total contract is started earlier and/or is not completed/ closed.

**II.** Bidder must submit **documentary evidence** issued by the owner, in support of having met the **Qualifying requirements, alongwith their Technical offer**. These documentary evidence may include:

1. Relevant Purchase Orders/ Work Orders copies.
2. Work Completion & Performance Certificate against submitted Purchase Orders / Work Orders from the End user.

**III.** In case of composite work/BOQ, the bidder shall have to furnish Certificate from owner certifying the value of specific nature of work, as mentioned in Clause 1.0.

**IV.** Reference work executed by bidder as a sub-contractor may also be considered provided the certificate issued by the main contractor is duly certified by the Project Authority specifying the work executed by the sub-contractor in support of the qualifying requirements.

**V.** “**Holding Company**” and “**Subsidiary Company**” shall have the meaning ascribed to them as per Companies Act of India.

**VI.** Other income shall not be considered for arriving at annual turnover figures.

**VII.** For **Annual Turnover indicated in foreign currency**, the exchange rate as on seven (07) days prior to the date of techno-commercial bid opening shall be used.

**VIII.** All Financial figures mentioned above are **exclusive of GST**.

11.0 Notwithstanding anything stated above, the Employer reserves the right to undertake a physical assessment of the capacity and capabilities including financial capacity and capability of the Bidder / his Collaborator(s) / Associate(s) / Subsidiary(ies) / Group Company(ies) to perform the Contract, should the circumstances warrant such assessment in the overall interest of the Employer.

The physical assessment shall include but not be limited to the assessment of the office/facilities/banker’s/reference works by the Employer. A negative determination of such assessment of capacity and capabilities may result in the rejection of the Bid.

The above right to undertake the physical assessment shall be applicable for the qualifying requirements stipulated above.

- 12.0 NTPC reserves the right to reject any or all bids or cancel/withdraw the NIT for the subject package without assigning any reason whatsoever and in such case no bidder/intending bidder shall have any claim arising out of such action.
- 13.0 Issuance of Bidding Documents to any bidder shall not construe that bidder is considered qualified.
- 14.0 Participation in the tender does not automatically mean that the bidders are considered qualified. NTPC shall evaluate the qualifying requirements of each bidder as per NIT after opening of Technical Commercial bids and the bids of the bidder who is not meeting the qualifying requirement shall be treated as non-responsive.
