If the bidder wants to avail the Purchase preference, the bidder must upload a certificate from the OEM regarding the percentage of the local content and the details of locations at which the local value addition is made along with their bid, failing which no purchase preference shall be granted. In case the bid value is more than Rs 10 Crore, the declaration relating to percentage of local content shall be certified by the statutory auditor or cost auditor, if the OEM is a company and by a practicing cost accountant or a chartered accountant for OEMs other than companies as per the Public Procurement (preference to Make-in -India) order 2017 dated 04.06.2020. If the bidder wants to avail the Purchase preference, the bidder must be the manufacturer of the offered product in case of bid for supply of goods. Traders are excluded from the purview of Public Procurement Policy for Micro and Small Enterprises. In respect of bid for Services, the bidder must be the Service provider of the offered Service. Relevant documentary evidence in this regard shall be uploaded along with the bid in respect of the offered product or service. If L-1 is not an MSE and MSE Seller (s) has/have quoted price within L-1+ 15% (Selected by Buyer)of margin of purchase preference /price band defined in relevant policy, such Seller shall be given opportunity to match L-1 price and contract will be awarded for 100%(selected by Buyer) percentage of total QUANTITY.

# **Buyer Added Bid Specific Additional Terms and Conditions**

- 1. Actual delivery (and Installation & Commissioning (if covered in scope of supply)) is to be done at following address Kavadiguda Road, Musheerabad, Bansilalpet, Hyderabad, Telangana 500020.
- 2. Bidder's offer is liable to be rejected if they don't upload any of the certificates / documents sought in the Bid document, ATC and Corrigendum if any.
- 3. Bidders are advised to check applicable GST on their own before quoting. Buyer will not take any responsibility in this regards. GST reimbursement will be as per actuals or as per applicable rates (whichever is lower), subject to the maximum of quoted GST %.
- 4. Bidder shall submit the following documents along with their bid for Vendor Code Creation:
  - a. Copy of PAN Card.
  - b. Copy of GSTIN.
  - c. Copy of Cancelled Cheque.
  - d. Copy of EFT Mandate duly certified by Bank.
- 5. Data Sheet of the product(s) offered in the bid, are to be uploaded along with the bid documents. Buyers can match and verify the Data Sheet with the product specifications offered. In case of any unexplained mismatch of technical parameters, the bid is liable for rejection.
- 6. Purchase preference to Micro and Small Enterprises (MSEs): Purchase preference will be given to MSEs as defined in Public Procurement Policy for Micro and Small Enterprises (MSEs) Order, 2012 dated 23.03.2012 issued by Ministry of Micro, Small and Medium Enterprises and its subsequent Orders/Notifications issued by concerned Ministry. - 7. The bidder is required to upload, along with the bid, all relevant certificates such as BIS licence, type test certificate, approval certificates and other certificates as prescribed in the Product Specification given in the bid document.
- 8. Without prejudice to Buyer's right to price adjustment by way of discount or any other right or remedy available to Buyer, Buyer may terminate the Contract or any part thereof by a written notice to the Seller, if:
  - i) The Seller fails to comply with any material term of the Contract.

ii) The Seller informs Buyer of its inability to deliver the Material(s) or any part thereof within the stipulated Delivery Period or such inability otherwise becomes apparent.

iii) The Seller fails to deliver the Material(s) or any part thereof within the stipulated Delivery Period and/or to replace/rectify any rejected or defective Material(s) promptly.

- iv) The Seller becomes bankrupt or goes into liquidation.
- v) The Seller makes a general assignment for the benefit of creditors.
- vi) A receiver is appointed for any substantial property owned by the Seller.
- vii) The Seller has misrepresented to Buyer, acting on which misrepresentation Buyer has placed the

Purchase Order on the Seller.

- 9. While generating invoice in GeM portal, the seller must upload scanned copy of GST invoice and the screenshot of GST portal confirming payment of GST.
- 10. Buyer Added text based ATC clauses

#### 10.1. Warranty:

1. All hardware and software supplied under the project shall be under on-site warranty backed by respective OEMs (Original equipment manufacturer) for Six (06) years. Bidder to submit certificate from respective OEMs for availability of back to back on-site warranty for 06 years.

2. All support services, replacements of faulty systems or sub-systems provided during the warranty, logistics for transport of spares etc., during the warranty shall be free of cost and services shall be provided at owner's premises.

3. Call registration number and contact details with escalation matrix to be shared by OEM hardware support team.

4. During the concurrency of contract, bidder shall promptly attend to any hardware/software breakdown complaint and get the problem resolved in shortest possible time at owner's site.

5. Maximum THREE (03) working days resolution time for all hardware related issues. Resolution shall involve supply of replacement of faulty sub-system, installation and restoration of services. In case of hardware issue, if ability of server to provide required application service is not compromised the server shall be considered as up & running for the duration.

6. In case of delay is beyond THREE (03) working days the warranty period shall be correspondingly extended by 1 week for each event of non-compliance.

#### 10.2. Payment Terms:

100% of quoted price along with applicable taxes shall be released after Supply and installation of the Server and acceptance by NTPC as per the Scope of work.

Payment shall be processed subject to submission of the following:

a) Vendor E-Invoice in NTPC Pradip System.

b) Submission of CPG.

c) Certification by the Engineer-in-Charge (EIC) that the Server has been supplied and installed as per scope of work.

d) Submission of by Bidder of Warranty certificates and back-up support guarantee for all hardware and software products from respective OEMs through assurance letter/certificates to NTPC for on-site warranty support of SIX (06) years as per warranty terms above.

**10.3. Time Schedule:** Supply and Installation within 3 Months from PO placement date.

**10.4.** The local content requirement to categorize a Bidder/Supplier as 'Class-I local supplier' is minimum 50%. For 'Class-II local supplier', the 'local content' requirement is minimum 20%.

## **10.5. Contract Performance Security:**

The successful bidder shall be required to furnish the Contract Performance Guarantee (CPG) for an amount equal to 3% of total order value. CPG should be valid for a period of three months (3 months) beyond the expiry of warranty period.

The CPG should be submitted within 30 days of placement of award.

- **10.6.** If the Bidder is not the OEM of Server then the Bidder should also submit letter of authorization for this tender from the OEM of the Server.
- **10.7.** All bids must be accompanied by "**Bid Security Declaration**" in lie of Bid Security in the form as per format attached at **Annexure 1** to this document.

Bidder may note that in case they do not submit the aforesaid declaration or no confirmation is indicated by them or statement/any declaration like 'later', 'to be furnished later', 'NA' etc. are indicated against the declaration, then the bid shall be rejected by EMPLOYER as being non-responsive and shall not be opened.

# Disclaimer

The additional terms and conditions have been incorporated by the Buyer after approval of the Competent Authority in Buyer Organization.
