ii) "Class-I local suppliers' only are eligible to participate in this tender, as defined in the bidding documents/ Public Procurement (Preference to Make in India), Order 2017 and its subsequent amendments/ revisions issued by DPIIT. The bidders may apprise themselves of the relevant provisions of bidding documents in this regard before submission of their bids."

Bidders are requested to give acceptance of meeting the MLC (Minimum Local Content) requirement by accepting the GTE & declaration as per Attachment-10 to Section-VIII of Forms & Procedures.

By accepting the MLC provision of GTE it will be considered that:-

"Bidder is 'Class-I local supplier' and is meeting the MLC requirement stipulated in Annexure-I to BDS.

Also supplier has not been debarred / banned by any other procuring entity for violation of 'Public Procurement (Preference to Make In India), Order 2017' (PPP-MII Order) dated 15.06.2017 and its subsequent revisions / amendments issued by Department for Promotion of Industry and Internal trade (DPIIT)".

No further claim in this regard shall be entertained by the Employer.

In case false declaration in respect of Local content, same shall be treated as false declaration and will be dealt in line with the Fraud Prevention Policy of NTPC.

The bidders may apprise themselves of the relevant provisions of bidding documents in this regard before submission of their bids.

- 5. Bidder has to ensure the following documents to be submitted offline (in case paid in modes other than on-line payment) and the same should reach in sealed envelopes before the bid submission deadline prescribed by the Employer, pursuant to ITB, failing which bidis liable for rejection
 - a) Tender Fee: Applicable
 - b) Integrity Pact: Not Applicable

Any bid not accompanied by Bid Security Declaration, Tender fees (If applicable) and/or Integrity pact (If applicable) shall be rejected by the Employer as being non-responsive and shall be rejected without being opened.

6. Qualifying Requirements for Bidders:

The Bidder should meet the minimum Qualifying Requirements as stipulated here under:

A. Technical Criteria (Similar Work):

The bidder should have at least two (02) ambulance in its fleet and should have successfully executed/completed the works of providing ambulance service in any organization/ hospital during the preceding seven (07) years reckoned from the date of techno-commercial bid opening.

B. Financial Criteria of Bidder:

- 1. The average annual financial turnover of the bidder during the last three (03) financial years as on the date of Techno-commercial bid opening should not be less than **Rs. 32.13 lakhs** (Thirty Two Lakhs and Thirteen Thousand Only).
- 2. The bidder should have successfully executed any one of the following "Similar work" during the preceding seven (07) years as on the date of Techno-commercial bid opening:
 - a) Single (01) order of contract value not less than **Rs. 25.70 Lakhs**.

OR

- b) Two (02) orders, each of contract value not less than **Rs. 16.06 Lakhs.** OR
- c) Three (03) orders, each of contact value not less than **Rs. 12.85 Lakhs.**

Note:

- a. The word "executed" mentioned above means the bidder should have achieved the abovementioned financial criteria (B.2), even if the total contract is started earlier and / or is not completed/closed.
- b. In case where audited results for the last financial year as on the date of Technocommercial bid opening are not available, the financial results certified by a practicing Chartered Accountant shall be considered acceptable. In case bidder is not able to submit the certificate from practicing Chartered accountant, certifying its financial parameters, the audited results of the three consecutive financial years preceding the last financial year shall be considered for evaluating the financial parameters. Further, a certificate would be required from the CEO/CFO as per the format enclosed in the bidding documents stating that the financial results of the company are under audit as on the date of Technocommercial bid opening and the certificates from the practicing Chartered. Accountant certifying the financial parameters are not available.
- C. In case the bidder is not able to furnish it's audited financial statements on standalone entity basis, the un-audited unconsolidated financial statements of the bidder can be considered acceptable provided the bidder further furnishes the following documents for substantiation of its qualification:
- i) Copies of the un-audited unconsolidated financial statements of the bidder along with copies of the audited consolidated financial statements of the holding company.
- ii) A certificate from the CEO/ CFO of the Holding Company, as per the format enclosed in the bidding documents, stating that the un-audited unconsolidated financial statements form part of the Consolidated Financial Statements of the Holding Company.
- d. Other income shall not be considered for arriving at annual turnover.
- e. The bidder should have a separate valid GST registration number and PAN Number.

- f. Notwithstanding anything stated above, the Employer reserves the right to assess the capabilities and capacity of the Bidder/ his collaborators / associates/ subsidiaries/ group companies to perform the contract, should the circumstances warrant such assessment in the overall interest of the Employer.
- 7. Employer reserves the right to reject any or all bids or cancel/withdraw the Invitation for Bids without assigning any reason whatsoever and in such case no bidder / intending bidder shall have any claim arising out of such action.
- 8. Any 'Bidder from a country which shares a land border with India', as specified in the Bidding Documents, will be eligible to bid in this tender only if bidder is registered with the Competent Authority as mentioned in the Bidding Documents.

However, the said requirement of registration will not apply to bidders from those countries (even if sharing a land border with India) to which the Government of India has extended lines of credit or in which the Government of India is engaged in development projects.

10. Clarification on bidding documents:

- 11. Issuance of Bidding Documents to any Bidder shall not construe that such Bidder is considered qualified.
- 12. Transfer of Bidding Documents purchased by one intending Bidder to another is not permissible.
