#### 2.0 Brief Details:

Barauni Thermal Power Station is an existing 720 megawatt coal-fired power station earlier owned by Bihar State Electricity Board (BSEB). The power station is located at Barauni in Begusarai district, Bihar, India. NTPC completed the acquisition of 720 MW Barauni thermal power plant with effect from 15 December 2018.

3.1.1	ROUTE-I: The bidder must have successfully executed work of "(A) Operation of DCS/PLC based coal handling plant, field equipments/ systems & auxiliaries and (B) Maintenance (including mechanical, electrical and control & instrumentation maintenance works) of equipments/ systems for a coal handling plant with minimum coal handling capacity of 300 MT/Hr/Stream in a thermal power station" for a minimum continuous period of one year in a maximum of two contracts during last seven years reckoned from the date of techno-commercial bid opening. 3.1.2	<b>ROUTE-II</b> : The bidder should have "erected and commissioned atleast one Coal Handling Plant" in India, having design capacity of minimum 6,000 MT per day in last 7 years reckoned from the date of techno-commercial bid opening.

3.2	FINANCIAL CRITERIA:		
3.2.1	The average annual turnover of the bidder in the preceding three (03) financial years		
3.2.2	reckoned from the date of Techno-Commercial bid opening, should not be less than Rs. 7.20 Crores (INR Seven Crores and Twenty Lakhs only).  In case a Bidder does not satisfy the average annual financial turnover criteria		

- Techno-Commercial Bid Documents, pledging unconditional & irrevocable financial support for the execution of the Contract by the Bidder in case of award.
- 3.2.3 In case the bidder is not able to furnish its audited financial statements on stand-alone entity basis, the unaudited unconsolidated financial statements of the bidder can be considered acceptable provided the bidder further furnishes the following documents for substantiation of its qualification:
  - i) Copies of the unaudited unconsolidated financial statements of the bidder along with copies of the audited consolidated financial statements of the Holding Company.
  - ii) A certificate from the CEO/CFO of the Holding Company, as per the format enclosed in the bidding documents, stating that the unaudited unconsolidated financial statements form part of the consolidated financial statements of the Holding Company.
- In cases where audited results for the last financial year as on the date of Technocommercial bid opening are not available, the financial results certified by a practicing Chartered Accountant shall be considered acceptable. In case, Bidder is not able to submit the certificate from practicing Chartered Accountant certifying its financial parameters, the audited results for the three (03) consecutive financial years preceding the last financial year shall be considered for evaluating the financial parameters.

Further, a **certificate** would be required **from CEO/CFO** as per the format enclosed in the bidding document stating that the financial results of the company are under audit as on the date of Techno-commercial bid opening and the certificate from the practicing Chartered Accountant certifying financial parameters is not available.

3.2.3 Net worth of the Bidder should not be less than 100% (hundred percent) of its paid up share capital as on the last day of the preceding Financial year on the due date of Techno commercial bid opening.

In case the Bidder does not meet the Net worth criteria on its own, it can meet the requirements of Net worth based on the strength of its **Subsidiary(ies)** and/or Holding Company and/or Subsidiaries of the Holding Companies wherever applicable. In such a case, however the Net worth of the Bidder and its Subsidiary(ies) and/or Holding Company and/or Subsidiaries of the Holding Companies, in combined manner should not be less than 100% of their total paid up share capital. However individually, their Net worth should not be less than 75% of their respective paid up share capitals.

#### Net worth in combined manner shall be calculated as follows:

Net worth (combined)= [ (X1+ X2 +X3) / (Y1 +Y2+Y3)] X 100 Where X1, X2, X3 are individual Net worth which should not be less than 75% of the respective paid up share capitals and Y1, Y2, Y3 are individual paid up share capitals.

3.2.4 In case bidder is participating through Route-1:

Reference works executed by the Bidder, as a member of Joint Venture/ Consortium/ **Associate** can also be considered provided:

- a) The allocation of scope of work between the partners of the Joint Venture / Consortium/ Associate is clearly defined in the executed Joint Venture Agreement/ Consortium Agreement/ Deed of Joint Undertaking and Bidder's scope of work and break-up of quantities executed by them as individual contribution in the Joint Venture/ Consortium/ Associate, duly authenticated by the Project Authority, meet the relevant provisions of qualifying requirement.
- b) In case the reference work has been executed by the Bidder in an integrated Joint Venture wherein allocation of scope of work and **break-up of quantities between the partners is**

**not clearly specified** in the integrated Joint Venture Agreement, then the credit of executed quantities can be claimed by the bidder in the ratio of bidder's share in the integrated Joint Venture Agreement, provided the bidder establishes that it regularly undertakes works as at **Clause 3.1.1 above**. The executed works/quantities by integrated Joint Venture shall be duly authenticated by the Project Authority.

c) However, the bidder will not be eligible to claim the credit of executed work by integrated Joint Venture for **Clause 3.2.1** above, unless the bidder has individually executed the work meeting the requirement of **Clause 3.2.1** above and which has been duly authenticated by the Project Authority.

### **Clarificatory Notes for the Clauses above:**

- (i) The word "**Executed**" mentioned above means that the bidder should have achieved the criteria specified above within the preceding seven (07) years period, even if the total contract is started earlier and/or is not completed/ closed.
- (ii) Reference work executed by **bidder as a sub-contractor** may also be considered provided the **certificate issued by** the **main contractor** is duly **certified by the Project Authority** specifying the work executed by the sub-contractor in support of the qualifying requirements.
- (iii) Bidder must submit requisite **credentials in support of** having met the **qualifying requirements, along with** their **technical bid**. Credentials may include: a. Purchase Order/ Work Order copies. b. Work Completion / Performance Certificate from the End user
- (iv) **Net worth means** the sum total of the paid up share capital and free reserves. Free reserve means all reserves credited out of the profits and share premium account, but does not include reserves credited out of the revaluation of the assets, write back of depreciation provision and amalgamation. Further any debit balance of Profit and Loss account and miscellaneous expenses to the extent not adjusted or written off, if any, shall be reduced from reserves and surplus.
- (v) **Other income** shall not be considered for arriving at annual turnover figures.
- (vi) "Holding Company" and "Subsidiary Company" shall have the meaning ascribed to them as per Companies Act of India.
- (vii) For **Annual Turnover indicated in foreign currency**, the exchange rate as on seven (07) days prior to the date of techno commercial bid opening shall be used.
- (viii) All Financial figures mentioned above are exclusive of GST

#### 4.0 Techno-Commercial Bid (i.e. Technical Bid & Price Bid ) Submission :

This is an E-tender case and bidders shall submit bid (i.e. Technical Bid & Price Bid) in ONLINE ONLY. Bids sent in physical form thru any other means /media is not at all acceptable and it may be liable for rejection.
