Korba Super Thermal Power plant is located in Jamniali in Korba district in the Indian state of Chhattisgarh.

* **Micro and Small Enterprises (MSEs)** registered with District Industries Centers (DICs) or NSIC or Khadi & Village Industries Commission (KVIC) or Khadi & Village Industries Board (KVIB) or Coir Board or Directorate of Handicrafts and Handloom or Any other body specified by Ministry of Micro, Small & Medium Enterprises (M/o MSME) having Udyam Registration, for goods produced and services rendered, shall be issued the bid documents free of cost and shall be exempted from paying Earnest Money Deposit.

2.0	Qualifying Requirements: The bidders who wish to participate in the bidding shall satisfactorily establish that they fulfil the following Qualifying Requirements.
2.1	<u>Technical Criteria</u>

2.1.1	<p>(a) The bidder should have manufactured and supplied minimum Ten (10) nos. of three phase SF6 circuit breakers suitable for Air Insulated Substation / Switchyard of 6.6 KV or above class which must have been in successful operation for a minimum period of two (02) years as on the date of Techno-Commercial bid opening.</p> <p>(b) The bidder should have executed a contract which includes manufacturing and supply of three phase 6.6 KV or above SF6 circuit breakers during the preceding seven (07) years reckoned as on date of Techno-commercial bid opening as per the following:</p> <p style="padding-left: 40px;">i) Executed value not less than Rs 93 Lakhs in a Single Contract.</p> <p style="text-align: center;">OR</p> <p style="padding-left: 40px;">ii) Executed value not less than Rs 58 Lakhs in Two Contracts each.</p> <p style="text-align: center;">OR</p> <p style="padding-left: 40px;">iii) Executed value not less than Rs 46 Lakhs in Three Contracts each.</p>
Notes	<p>Notes for Clause 2.1.1 above:</p> <p>The word “executed” means the bidder should have achieved the criterion specified in the Qualifying Requirements, even if the total contract is not completed / closed. In case of contract(s) under execution as on date of techno commercial bid opening, the value of work executed till such date will be considered provided the same is certified by the employer.</p>
2.2	Financial criteria
2.2.1	<p>The average annual turnover of the bidder, in the preceding three (3) financial years as on date of Techno-Commercial bid opening, shall not be less than Rs 116 Lakh (Rupees One Hundred and Sixteen Lakhs Only).</p>
2.2.2	<p>In case the bidder is not able to furnish its audited financial statements on standalone entity basis, the unaudited unconsolidated financial statements of the bidder can be considered acceptable provided the bidder furnishes the following further documents on substantiation of its qualification:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Copies of the unaudited unconsolidated financial statements of the bidder along with copies of the audited consolidated financial statements of the Holding Company. • A certificate from the CEO/CFO of the Holding Company as per the format enclosed in the bid documents stating that the unaudited unconsolidated financial statements form part of the consolidated annual report of the company.
2.2.3	<p>In case where audited results for the last financial year as on the date of Techno Commercial Bid Opening are not available, the financial results certified by a practicing Chartered Accountant shall be considered acceptable. In case, Bidder is not able to submit the Certificate from practicing Chartered Accountant certifying its financial parameters, the audited results of three consecutive financial years preceding the last financial year shall be considered</p>

	for evaluating the financial parameters. Further, a certificate would be required from the CEO/CFO as per the format enclosed in the bidding documents stating that the financial results of the Company are under audit as on the date of Techno-Commercial Bid Opening and the Certificate from the practicing Chartered Accountant certifying the financial parameters is not available.
Note	Other income shall not be considered for arriving at annual turnover.

1. Techno Commercial Bid Opening date shall be first scheduled Techno Commercial Bid Opening Date.
2. Bidder should have a separate valid GST registration number and PAN Number.
3. Notwithstanding anything stated above, the Employer reserves the right to assess the capabilities and capacity of the Bidder/ his collaborators/ associates/ subsidiaries/group companies to perform the contract should the circumstances warrant such assessment in the overall interest of the Employer.

Legible copies of the following documents duly authenticated by the authorized representative of the bidder shall be submitted in support of the qualifying requirements along with technical bid:	
a)	Copy of Deed of Joint undertaking, if applicable.

c)	Copy of Micro & Small Enterprise (MSE) certificate [or Udyam Registration certificate), as an exemption certificate in lieu of tender fee/EMD, should be uploaded in Fee/EMD envelope of the online bid.
d)	Copy of profit and loss account and balance sheet for preceding three (3) completed financial years a son date of bid opening.
e)	Copy of Power Attorney of authorized signatory.
f)	Other relevant documents in support of qualifying requirements.

Bid reserved for Make In India products: : Procurement under this bid is reserved for purchase from Class 1 local supplier as defined in public procurement (Preference to Make in India), Order 2017 as amended from time to time and its subsequent Orders/Notifications issued by concerned Nodal Ministry for specific Goods/Products. However, eligible micro and small enterprises will be allowed to participate. The minimum local content to qualify as a class 1 local supplier is denoted in the bid document. All bidders must upload a certificate from the OEM regarding the percentage of the local content and the details of locations at which the local value addition is made along with their bid, failing which the bid is liable to be rejected. In case the bid value is more than Rs 10 Crore, the declaration relating to percentage of local content shall be certified by the statutory auditor or cost auditor, if the OEM is a company and by a practicing cost accountant or a chartered accountant for OEMs other than companies as per the Public Procurement (preference to Make-in -India) order 2017 dated 04.06.2020 . In case Buyer has selected Purchase preference to Micro and Small Enterprises clause in the bid, the same will get precedence over this clause.

2. Purchase preference to Micro and Small Enterprises (MSEs): Purchase preference will be given to MSEs as defined in Public Procurement Policy for Micro and Small Enterprises (MSEs) Order, 2012 dated 23.03.2012 issued by Ministry of Micro, Small and Medium Enterprises and its subsequent Orders/Notifications issued by concerned Ministry. If the bidder wants to avail the Purchase preference, the bidder must be the manufacturer of the offered product in case of bid for supply of goods. Traders are excluded from the purview of Public Procurement Policy for Micro and Small Enterprises. In respect of bid for Services, the bidder must be the Service provider of the offered Service. Relevant documentary evidence in this regard shall be uploaded along with the bid in respect of the offered product or service. If L-1 is not an MSE and MSE Seller (s) has/have quoted price within L-1+ 15% (Selected by Buyer)of margin of purchase preference /price band defined in relevant policy, such Seller shall be given opportunity to match L-1 price and contract will be awarded for 25%(selected by Buyer) percentage of total QUANTITY.

Disclaimer

In terms of GeM GTC clause 26 regarding Restrictions on procurement from a bidder of a country which shares a land border with India, any bidder from a country which shares a land border with India will be eligible to bid in this tender only if the bidder is registered with the Competent Authority.
