1. NTPC invites on-line bids on Single Stage Two Envelope Bidding basis (Envelope-I: Techno-commercial Bid & Envelope-II: Price Bid) from Eligible Bidders for aforesaid package, as per the scope of work briefly mentioned hereinafter.

#### 2. Brief Scope of Work

The work will involve attending to Preventive maintenance, Routine maintenance, Breakdown maintenance, repairs, rectification, modification and attending to any type of defects in Coal Handling Plant of NTPC-Kudgi (including Belt Vulcanizing and Pulley lagging works).

The detailed scope and description of work covered under this package has been specified in relevant clause of Detailed Technical Specification.

NTPC intends to finance subject Package through Domestic Commercial Borrowings/Own sources.

3. Detailed Specification, Scope of Work and Terms and Conditions are given in the bidding document, which are available for examination and sale at our e Procurement Portal (https://eprocurentpc.nic.in/nicgep/app) and as per the following schedule:

# "No Queries from Bidders, whatsoever, shall be entertained by the Employer beyond the last date of receipt of Queries/ Pre-Bid Conference (if applicable) as specified above."

As per provisions of Bidding Documents, the Bidders shall submit "Techno-Commercial Proposal" and "Price Proposal" online (https://eprocurentpc.nic.in/nicgep/app), within the bid submission date and time as mentioned above. Only Techno-Commercial proposals will be opened on the date and timed mentioned above.

4. All bids must be accompanied by Tender Fees (Cost of Bidding Documents), Bid Security Declaration and Integrity Pact. Regarding 'Bid Security Declaration', Bidders are required to accept General Technical Evaluation (GTE) conditions on-line while submitting their bid. Integrity Pact shall be submitted as per instruction mentioned in ITB/ BDS.

Any bid without an acceptable Tender Fees (through online payment), Bid Security Declaration and Integrity Pact shall be rejected by Employer as being non-responsive and shall not be opened. HOWEVER, TENDER FEE EXEMPTION SHALL BE APPLICABLE FOR MSE BIDDERS AS THE CASE MAY BE. For details, please refer ITB/ BDS/SCC Clause.

#### 5. Qualifying Requirements for Bidders:

The bidder who wishes to participate in the bidding shall meet the Qualifying Requirements stipulated hereunder:

- **5.1.** Technical Criteria:
- 5.1.1.The bidder should have executed similar works during the preceding seven (07) years reckoned as on the date of techno commercial bid opening with executed contract value(s) as below:
  - i) Single contract with executed value not less than Rs. 404.58 lakhs

OR

ii)Two contracts with executed values not less than Rs. 252.86 lakhs each

**Similar work** means is as explained in the following paragraph:

The bidder should have "erected and commissioned Coal Handling Plant in India, handling capacity of minimum 10,000 Tonnes of coal per day" in the preceding 7 years reckoned as on the date of techno commercial bid opening.

#### AND/OR

The bidder should have executed " 'operation and Maintenance' or 'Maintenance' works of Coal Handling Plant in India, handling capacity of minimum 10,000 Tonnes of coal per day for a period of two years or more in a single contract or repeat contract" in the preceding seven (07) years reckoned as on the date of techno-commercial bid opening.

#### Notes:

- 1. The word "executed" means the bidder should have achieved the criterion specified in the QR, even if the contract is not completed /closed. In case of contracts under execution as on date of techno-commercial bid opening, the value of work executed till such date will be considered provided the same is certified by the employer.
- 2. Repeat contract means, even if original contract was awarded for smaller duration, the same contract period is extended; the total duration shall include extended duration, in addition to original contract duration for the purpose of evaluation.
- 3. Reference work executed by the bidder as a sub-contractor may also be considered provided that certificate issued by main contractor is duly certified by owner specifying the scope of work executed by the sub-contractor in support of qualifying requirements.

#### 5.2. Financial criteria:

- 5.2.1. The average annual turnover of the bidder in the preceding three (03) financial years, reckoned as on the date of techno commercial bid opening shall not be less than **Rs. 505.72 lakhs (Rupees Five hundred five lakhs and seventy-two thousand only).**
- 5.2.2. In case a Bidder does not satisfy the annual turnover criteria, stipulated above on its own, its Holding Company would be required to meet the stipulated turnover requirements as above, provided that the Net Worth of such Holding Company as on the last day of the preceding financial year is at least equal to or more than the paid-up share capital of the Holding Company. In such an event, the Bidder would be required to furnish along with its Techno- commercial bid, a Letter of Undertaking from the Holding Company, supported by the Holding Company's Board Resolution, as per the format enclosed in the bid documents, pledging unconditional and irrevocable financial support for the execution of the Contract by the Bidder in case of award
- 5.2.3. Net Worth of the bidder should not be less than 100% of the bidder's paid up share capital as on the last day of the preceding financial year on the date of Techno-commercial bid opening. In case the Bidder meets the requirement of Networth based on the strength of its Subsidiary(ies) and/or Holding Company and/or Subsidiary(ies) of its Companies, wherever applicable, the Net worth of the Bidder and its Subsidiary(ies) and or Holding Company and/or Subsidiary(ies) of the Holding company, in combined manner should not be less than 100% of their total paid up share capital. However individually, their Net worth should not be less than 75% of their respective paid up share capitals. Networth in combined manner shall be calculated as follows:

Net worth (combined) = [ (X1 + X2 + X3) / (Y1 + Y2 + Y3) ] X 100

Where X1, X2, X3 are individual Net worth which should not be less than 75% of the respective paid up share capitals and Y1, Y2, Y3 are individual paid up share capitals.

5.2.4. In case the bidder is not able to furnish its audited financial statements on standalone entity basis, the unaudited unconsolidated financial statements of the bidder can be considered acceptable provided the bidder further furnishes the following documents for substantiation of its qualification.

i)Copies of the unaudited unconsolidated financial statements of the bidder along with copies of the audited consolidated financial statements of its Holding Company.

ii)A Certificate from the CEO/CFO of the Holding Company, as per the format enclosed in the bidding documents, stating that the unaudited unconsolidated financial statements of the bidder shall form part of the Audited Consolidated Annual Report of the Holding Company.

5.2.5. In cases where audited results for the last financial year as on the date of Techno-Commercial bid opening are not available, the financial results certified by a practicing Chartered Accountant shall be considered acceptable. In case, Bidder is not able to submit the Certificate from a practicing Chartered Accountant certifying its financial parameters, the audited results of three consecutive financial years preceding the last financial year shall be considered for evaluating the financial parameters.

#### Notes

- a) Other income shall not be considered for arriving at annual turnover.
- b) Net worth means the sum total of the paid up share capital and free reserves. Free reserves means all reserves credited out of the profits and share premium account but does not include reserves credited out of the revaluation of the assets, write back of depreciation provision and amalgamation. Further any debit balance of Profit and Loss account and miscellaneous expenses to the extent not adjusted or written off, if any, shall be reduced from reserves and surplus.
- c) "Holding Company" and "Subsidiary Company" shall have the meaning ascribed to them as per Companies Act of India, in vogue.
- d) For the purpose of arriving at the executed value of work specified at **5.1** above, basic amount only shall be considered. In case of a contract inclusive of Taxes, agency has to provide the break-up of basic value and tax.
- e) The value of the work completed in the preceding seven (07) years reckoned as on date of techno-commercial bid opening, even if it has been started earlier, will only be considered for establishing the qualifying requirements.
- f) The bidder should submit the documentary proof for establishing the QR requirements at 5.1 and 5.2 above.
- 6. Notwithstanding anything stated above, the Employer reserves the right to assess the capabilities and capacity of the Bidder/ his collaborators / associates/ subsidiaries / group companies to perform the contract, should the circumstances warrant such assessment in the overall interest of the Employer.
- 7. 'Class-I local suppliers' only are eligible to participate in this tender, as defined in the bidding documents/ Public Procurement (Preference to Make in India), Order 2017 and its subsequent amendments/ revisions issued by DPIIT. The bidders may apprise themselves of the relevant provisions of bidding documents in this regard before submission of their bids.

8. Any 'Bidder from a country which shares a land border with India', as specified in the Bidding Documents, will be eligible to bid in this tender only if bidder is registered with the Competent Authority as mentioned in the Bidding Documents.

However, the said requirement of registration will not apply to bidders from those countries (even if sharing a land border with India) to which the Government of India has extended lines of credit or in which the Government of India is engaged in development projects.

- 9. NTPC reserves the right to reject any or all bids or cancel/withdraw the NIT for the subject package without assigning any reason whatsoever and in such case no bidder/intending bidder shall have any claim arising out of such action.
- 10. Issuance of bid documents to any bidder shall not construe that such bidder is considered to be qualified. Bids shall be submitted online and opened at the address given below in the presence of Bidder's representatives who choose to attend the bid opening.
- 11. The bidding document is available online. A complete set of Bidding Documents may be downloaded by any interested Bidder from the NTPC tender website <u>https://eprocurentpc.nic.in</u>. The Bidder would be required to register on the website.

First time users are required to register themselves on NTPC tender website (<u>https://eprocurentpc.nic.in</u>) after filling up the required details.
