1.0 NTPC Limited (NTPC) invites online bids on "Single Stage Two Envelope Bidding Basis" from eligible bidders for aforesaid package, as per the scope of work briefly mentioned hereinafter.

### 2.0 BRIEF SCOPE OF WORK

The scope of the proposal **includes, installation, testing & commissioning of supplied isolator complete in all respect with its support insulator, marshalling box, interfacing cables as per specification and dismantling of existing isolator** shall be on the basis of single point responsibility completely covering the activities and services in respect of all the equipment & works specified and covered under the specifications and read in conjunction with "Scope of Supply & services" elaborated elsewhere.

**3.0** Detailed Specification, Scope of Work and Terms & Conditions are given in the Bidding Documents, which are available for examination and Sale at our eProcurement Portal (https://eprocurentpc.nic.in/nicgep/app) and as per the following schedule:

4.0 All bids must be accompanied by Bid Security Declaration in the form as stipulated in the Bidding documents. Bid Security Declaration shall be submitted by acceptance of General Technical Evaluation (GTE) Attribute "Do you accept Bid Security Declaration" in GePNIC portal.

## In case a bidder does not submit the aforesaid declaration, then the bid shall be rejected by employer as being non-responsive and shall not be opened.

Option for Online payment of tender fee is also made available at GePNIC /e tender portal. Bidders are requested to please avail the facility.

- **5.0** Bidder has to ensure the following documents to be submitted online, pursuant to ITB Clause 15, failing which bid is liable for rejection
  - a) Tender Fee: As applicable
  - b) Earnest Money Deposit/Bid Security:

All bids must be accompanied by "Bid Security Declaration" in lieu of Bid Security in the GePNIC attribute.

Any bid not accompanied by acceptance of GePNIC attribute of "Bid Security Declaration" shall be rejected by the employer as being non-responsive and shall not be opened.

c) Integrity Pact: Not Applicable

# 7.0 **QUALIFYING REQUIREMENTS FOR BIDDERS**.

The bidders who wish to participate in the bidding shall satisfactorily establish that they fulfill the following Qualifying Requirements.

# 7.1 Technical Criteria:

7.1.1 The bidder should be a manufacturer or authorized by the manufacturer of 220 KV Isolators and should have Supplied at least 10 (Ten) Nos. of '220 KV, 1600A' or above rating Isolators within the preceding seven (7) years prior to the date of Techno Commercial Bid Opening.

#### AND

- **7.1.2** The bidder should have executed/got executed the work(s) of 'Erection / Installation / Commissioning / R&M' of 'Isolators/ Switchyard/ Switchyard Equipment(s)/ Sub-Station' of 220 KV or Above Voltage level, within the preceding seven (7) years prior to the date of Techno Commercial Bid Opening, meeting the following criteria:
- (i) Single order having executed value of above work not less than **Rs. 210.82 Lakh**.

OR

 (ii) Two orders having executed value of above work(s) not less than Rs 131.76 Lakh each.

OR

(iii) Three orders having executed value of above work(s) not less than **Rs. 105.41 Lakh each**.

# Notes for Clause 7.1 above:

- (i) The word "executed" means the Bidder should have achieved the criteria specified in the qualifying requirements within the preceding seven (7) year period even if the contract has been started earlier and/or is not completed/ closed.
- (ii) Reference work executed by a bidder as a sub-contractor may also be considered provided the certificate issued by main contractor is duly certified by project Authority specifying the scope of work executed by the sub-contractor in support of Qualifying Requirements.
- (iii) Full Executed value shall be considered for evaluation of Financial QR of 7.1 above, for Purchase Orders of 'Isolators/ Switchyard/ Switchyard Equipment' 'Erection / Installation / Commissioning / R&M' works with other related activities like Equipment(s)/ structure/Panel/Cabling/ Testing cost etc. shall be considered to calculate executed values for QR evaluation.

# 7.2 Financial Criteria:

The average annual turnover of the Bidder, in the preceding three (3) financial years as on the date of Techno-Commercial bid opening, should not be less than **Rs. 263.53 Lakh (Rupees Two Crore Sixty-Three-Lakh Fifty-Three-**Thousand Only).

- **7.2.1** In case a bidder does not satisfy the financial criteria, stipulated above on its own, its Holding Company would be required to meet the stipulated turnover requirements above, provided that the net worth of such Holding Company as on the last day of the preceding financial year is at least equal to or more than the paid-up share capital of the Holding Company. In such an event, the bidder would be required to furnish along with its Techno-Commercial bid, a Letter of Undertaking from the Holding Company, supported by the Holding Company's Board Resolution as per the format enclosed in the bid documents, pledging unconditional and irrevocable financial support for the execution of the Contract by the Bidder in case of award.
- **7.2.2** In case the bidder is not able to furnish its audited financial statements on standalone entity basis, the unaudited unconsolidated financial statements of the bidder can be considered acceptable provided the bidder further furnishes the following documents for substantiation of its qualification:
  - (a) Copies of the unaudited unconsolidated financial statements of the bidder along with copies of the audited consolidated financial statements of its Holding Company.
  - (b) A Certificate from the CEO/CFO of the Holding Company, as per the format enclosed in the bidding documents, stating that the unaudited unconsolidated financial statements form part of the consolidated annual financial statements of the Holding Company.

In case where audited results for the last financial year as on the date of techno commercial bid opening are not available, the financial results certified by a practising Chartered Accountant shall be considered acceptable. In case, Bidder is not able to submit the certificate from practising Chartered Accountant certifying its financial parameters, the audited results for the three consecutive financial years preceding the last financial year shall be considered for evaluating the financial parameters. Further, a Certificate would be required from the CEO/CFO as per the format enclosed in the bidding documents stating that the Financial results of the Company are under audit as on the date of Techno-commercial bid opening and the Certificate from the practising Chartered Accountant certifying the financial parameters is not available.

### Notes:

- (i) Other income shall not be considered for arriving at annual turnover.
- (ii) "Holding Company" and "Subsidiary" shall have the meaning ascribed to them as per Companies Act of India.
- (iii) For Turnover indicated in foreign currency, the exchange rate as on seven (07) days prior to the date of techno-commercial bid opening shall be used.
- (iv) All financial figures mentioned above are exclusive of GST.
- **8.0** Only Class-I local suppliers are eligible to participate in this tender, as defined in the bidding documents/ Public Procurement (Preference to Make in India), Order 2017 and its subsequent amendments/ revisions issued by DPIIT. The bidders may apprise themselves of the relevant provisions of bidding documents in this regard before submission of their bids."

The local content requirement to categorize a Bidder/ Supplier as 'Class-I local supplier' is minimum 50%. For 'Class-II local supplier', the 'local content' requirement is minimum 20%.

Only <sup>•</sup>Class I Local Supplier' shall be eligible for Purchase Preference. [Refer: Attached document *"Preference to Make-In-India and Eligibility for* Participation/ granting of purchase preference to Class I Local Suppliers"]

# Note:

- i. The bidder has to furnish declaration regarding local content in Employer's attached format for availing purchase preference. The duly filled-in declaration format is to be submitted in **TECHNO-COMMERCIAL BID COVER/ ENVELOPE.**
- ii. Also supplier has not been debarred / banned by any other procuring entity for violation of 'Public Procurement (Preference to Make In India), Order 2017' (PPP-MII Order) dated 15.06.2017 and its subsequent revisions / amendments issued by Department for Promotion of Industry and Internal trade (DPIIT)".
- iii. In case false declaration in respect of Local content, same shall be treated as false declaration and will be dealt in line with the Fraud Prevention Policy of NTPC.

The bidders may apprise themselves of the relevant provisions of bidding documents in this regard before submission of their bids.

**9.0** The Contractor shall not be allowed to sub-contract works to any sub-contractor/ sub-vendor from a country which shares a land border with India unless such sub-contractor is registered with the competent Authority.

The Competent Authority for the purpose of registration shall be as mentioned in the **Annexure - II** of SCC.

However, the said requirement of registration will not apply to sub-contractors from those countries (even if sharing a land border with India) to which the Government of India has extended lines of credit or in which the Government of India is engaged in development projects. The Contractor may apprise itself of the updated lists of such countries available in the website of the Ministry of External Affairs.

- **10.0** NTPC reserves the right to reject any or all bids or cancel / withdraw the Invitation for Bids/NIT without assigning any reason whatsoever and in such case no bidder / intending bidder shall have any claim arising out of such action.
- **11.0** Issuance of bid documents to any Bidder shall not construe that such bidder is considered to be qualified. Bids shall be submitted online and opened at the address given below in the presence of Bidder's representatives who choose to attend the bid opening.
- **12.0** Transfer of Bidding Documents purchased by one intending Bidder to another is not permissible.
