Section-I: EOI Information

1.0 ABOUT NTPC

NTPC is India's largest energy conglomerate with +66 GW power generating capacity, with roots planted way back in 1975 to accelerate power development in India. Since then, it has established itself as the dominant power major with a presence in the entire value chain of the power generation business. From fossil fuels, it has forayed into generating electricity via hydro, nuclear and renewable energy sources. This foray will play a major role in lowering its carbon footprint by reducing greenhouse gas emissions.

2.0 ABOUT NETRA

3.0 PURPOSE OF THE EOL

a. Background

NTPC intends to demonstrate hydrogen co-firing in existing gas turbine for power generation. Using hydrogen gas as a fuel in gas-turbine plays an important role in decarborbonization of the energy sector. NTPC is aggressively pushing for greening its portfolio and firing hydrogen in gas-turbine project is another step towards achieving the low carbon footprint. NTPC has a number of fleets of Gas turbine based Combined Cycle Power Plants where Natural Gas/RNLG/Naptha is being fired for power generation. If Hydrogen is co-fired with Natural gas/RNLG, the CO₂ emission from the gas turbine can be reduced.

b. Purpose of the EOI

The EOI is published to assess the amount of Hydrogen that can be made available "On-site" at the requisite quantity and quality as per "Scope of Work" given elsewhere in the document.

- i. Short term supply
- ii. Approximate cost of supply

After identifying the Indian/ Indian subsidiary of Global Company/ Consortium/ Affiliates/ Representatives (hereinafter called APPLICANT), contractual and

commercial proposals for "On-Site supply of hydrogen gas at 15-30 bar pressure for short term R&D Demonstration of H2 co-firing in NTPC Gas Turbines" in some selected gas Turbine shall be initiated separately.

- d. Connection, gas charging to the terminal point of NTPC, and its supervision during the course of operation.
- e. Uninterrupted supply of hydrogen during the required period.
- f. Any statutory clearance for temporary storing of H2 Cascade at NTPC Site.
- g. At present no storage capacity is envisaged at the Site.
