1. Bid reserved for Make In India products: : Procurement under this bid is reserved for purchase from Class 1 local supplier as defined in public procurement (Preference to Make in India), Order 2017 as amended from time to time and its subsequent Orders/Notifications issued by concerned Nodal Ministry for specific Goods/Products. However, eligible micro and small enterprises will be allowed to participate. The minimum local content to qualify as a class 1 local supplier is denoted in the bid document. All bidders must upload a certificate from the OEM regarding the percentage of the local content and the details of locations at which the local value addition is made along with their bid, failing which the bid is liable to be rejected. In case the bid value is more than Rs 10 Crore, the declaration relating to percentage of local content shall be certified by the statutory auditor or cost auditor, if the OEM is a company and by a practicing cost accountant or a chartered accountant for OEMs other than companies as per the Public Procurement (preference to Make-in -India) order 2017 dated 04.06.2020 . In case Buyer has selected Purchase preference to Micro and Small Enterprises clause in the bid, the same will get precedence over this clause.

2. Purchase preference to Micro and Small Enterprises (MSEs): Purchase preference will be given to MSEs as defined in Public Procurement Policy for Micro and Small Enterprises (MSEs) Order, 2012 dated 23.03.2012 issued by Ministry of Micro, Small and Medium Enterprises and its subsequent Orders/Notifications issued by concerned Ministry. If the bidder wants to avail the Purchase preference, the bidder must be the manufacturer of the offered product in case of bid for supply of goods. Traders are excluded from the purview of Public Procurement Policy for Micro and Small Enterprises. In respect of bid for Services, the bidder must be the Service provider of the offered Service. Relevant documentary evidence in this regard shall be uploaded along with the bid in respect of the offered product or service. If L-1 is not an MSE and MSE Seller (s) has/have quoted price within L-1+ 15% (Selected by Buyer)of margin of purchase preference /price band defined in relevant policy, such Seller shall be given opportunity to match L-1 price and contract will be awarded for 100%(selected by Buyer) percentage of total QUANTITY.

1. **EARNEST MONEY DEPOSIT (EMD) / BID SECURITY:** In the form of "Bid Security Declaration".

A) Bidders are required to accept "Bid Security Declaration.

B) By accepting the Bid Security Declaration, Bidders are deemed to confirm the following:

I hereby undertake not to withdraw or modify or impair or derogate from the bid in any respect within the period of validity of this bid. I undertake that the information / documents furnished in this bid are not false, misleading or forged. I also undertake to furnish requisite performance security / PBG within stipulated time required as per GeM bid / RA conditions. I understand that GeM has the right to debar me from GeM portal as per GeM GTC and GeM Incident Management Policy for violation of this declaration / undertaking.

QUALIFYING REQUIREMENTS FOR BIDDERS

The bidders who wish to participate in the bidding process shall satisfactorily establish with documentary evidence that they fulfil the following Qualifying Requirements:

1.1 Technical Criteria:

1.1.1. The bidder should be a manufacturer OR 'an authorized agent (dealer/distributor/channel partner) of manufacturer" of Heavy Commercial Vehicles (Trucks/Trippers)

1.1.2 (A) The bidder should have executed/completed supply of 'BS-VI compliant Truck/Tripper with Engine output of 180 HP or more and capacity of 10 Cubic Meter or above' prior to the last date of the month preceding the month of publication of NIT.

(B) The bidder should have executed/ completed similar order during the last seven (07) years. as on last date of the month preceding the month of publication of NIT, having minimum order values as indicated below:

(a) One order of value not less than Rs.44.80 Lakh,

(b) Two orders, each of value not less than Rs.28.00 Lakh,

(c) Three orders, each of value not less than Rs.22,.40 Lakh

Similar order means: Supply of Trucks/Trippers of any capacity

Notes (applicable to Clause 1.1 above):

(a) The word "executed/completed" means the bidder should have achieved the criteria specified in clause 1.1 of QR, even if the total order is not completed/closed. In case any order is under execution as on last date of the month preceding the month of publication of NIT, the value of order executed against such order till such date will be considered provided the same is certified by the Owner/Project Authority.

(b) Bidder as a manufacturer shall submit 'certificate of Incorporation /Manufacturing License or any other documentary evidence' to establish that they are manufacturer as per clause 1.1.1 above. The bidder as an authorized agent of the manufacturer, shall also submit "certificate of Incorporation /Manufacturing License or any other documentary evidence from the manufacturer to establish that their

principal is the manufacturer as per clause 1.1.1 above

(c) For this tender, either the Authorized agent or Manufacturer itself can bid but both cannot bid simultaneously. If an authorized agent submits bid on behalf of the Manufacturer, the same authorized agent shall not submit bid on behalf of another Manufacturer.

(d) For the purpose of arriving at the supplied value of order specified at clause 1.1.2 above. basic amount only shall be considered. In case of an order/ contract inclusive of Taxes, agency has to provide the break-up of basic value and tax.

2.2 Financial Criteria:

2.2.1 The average annual turnover of the bidder in the preceding three (3) Financial Years as on the date of techno-commercial bid opening shall not be less than **Rs. 56.00 lakh** (Indian Rupees Fifty Six Lakh Only)

2.2.2 **Notes** (applicable to Clause 2.2 above):

- (i) Other income shall not be considered for arriving at annual turnover.
- (ii) In case where audited results for the last financial year as on date of Techno commercial bid opening are not available, the financial results certified by a practicing Chartered Accountant shall be considered acceptable. In case, bidder is not able to submit the certificate from practicing Chartered Accountant certifying its financial parameters, the audited results of three consecutive financial years preceding the last financial year shall be considered for evaluating the financial parameters.
- (iii) Further, a certificate would be required from the CEO/CFO as per the format enclosed in the bidding documents stating that the financial results of the company are under audit as on the date of Techno Commercial bid opening and the certificate from the practicing Chartered Accountant certifying the financial parameters is not available.

(All relevant documents relevant to QR shall be submitted along with technical bid in ATC)

Disclaimer

The additional terms and conditions have been incorporated by the Buyer after approval of the Competent Authority in Buyer Organization. Buyer organization is solely responsible for the impact of these clauses on the bidding process, its outcome and consequences thereof including any eccentricity / restriction arising in the bidding process due to these ATCs and due to modification of technical specification and / or terms and conditions governing the bid. Any clause incorporated by the Buyer such as demanding Tender Sample, incorporating any clause against the MSME policy and Preference to make in India Policy, mandating any Brand names or Foreign Certification, changing the default time period for Acceptance of material or payment timeline governed by OM of Department of Expenditure shall be null and void and would not be considered part of bid. Further any reference of conditions published on any external site or reference to external documents / clauses shall also be null and void. If any seller has any objection / grievance against these additional clauses or otherwise on any aspect of this bid, they can raise their representation against the same by using the Representation window provided in the bid details field in Seller dashboard after logging in as a seller within 4 days of bid publication on GeM. Buyer is duty bound to reply to all such representations and would not be allowed to open bids if he fails to reply to such representations.
