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1. Preference to Make In India products (For bids < 200 Crore):Preference shall be given to Class 1 local supplier as defined in public procurement (Preference to Make in India), Order 2017 as amended from time to time and its subsequent Orders/Notifications issued by concerned Nodal Ministry for specific Goods/Products. The minimum local content to qualify as a Class 1 local supplier is denoted in the bid document. If the bidder wants to avail the Purchase preference, the bidder must upload a certificate from the OEM regarding the percentage of the local content and the details of locations at which the local value addition is made along with their bid, failing which no purchase preference shall be granted. In case the bid value is more than Rs 10 Crore, the declaration relating to percentage of local content shall be certified by the statutory auditor or cost auditor, if the OEM is a company and by a practicing cost accountant or a chartered accountant for OEMs other than companies as per the Public Procurement (preference to Make-in -India) order 2017 dated 04.06.2020. Only Class-I and Class-II Local suppliers as per MII order dated 4.6.2020 will be eligible to bid. Non - Local suppliers as per MII order dated 04.06.2020 are not eligible to participate. However, eligible micro and small enterprises will be allowed to participate .In case Buyer has selected Purchase preference to Micro and Small Enterprises clause in the bid, the same will get precedence over this clause.

2. Purchase preference to Micro and Small Enterprises (MSEs): Purchase preference will be given to MSEs as defined in Public Procurement Policy for Micro and Small Enterprises (MSEs) Order, 2012 dated 23.03.2012 issued by Ministry of Micro, Small and Medium Enterprises and its subsequent Orders/Notifications issued by concerned Ministry. If the bidder wants to avail the Purchase preference, the bidder must be the manufacturer of the offered product in case of bid for supply of goods. Traders are excluded from the purview of Public Procurement Policy for Micro and Small Enterprises. In respect of bid for Services, the bidder must be the Service provider of the offered Service. Relevant documentary evidence in this regard shall be uploaded along with the bid in respect of the offered product or service. If L-1 is not an MSE and MSE Seller (s) has/have quoted price within L-1+ 15% (Selected by Buyer)of margin of purchase preference /price band defined in relevant policy, such Seller shall be given opportunity to match L-1 price and contract will be awarded for 100%(selected by Buyer) percentage of total QUANTITY.

3. Estimated Bid Value indicated above is being declared solely for the purpose of guidance on EMD amount and for determining the Eligibility Criteria related to Turn Over, Past Performance and Project / Past Experience etc. This has no relevance or bearing on the price to be quoted by the bidders and is also not going to have any impact on bid participation. Also this is not going to be used as a criteria in determining reasonableness of quoted prices which would be determined by the buyer based on its own assessment of reasonableness and based on competitive prices received in Bid / RA process.

1.0 NTPC Limited (NTPC) invites online bids on “ **Single Stage Two Envelope Bidding Basis**” from eligible bidders for aforesaid package, as per the scope of work briefly mentioned hereinafter.

#### 2.0 **BRIEF SCOPE OF WORK**

The scope of the proposal for shall be **Procurement of Gate valve for mill inerting system for NTPC Ramagundam, Mouda** on the basis of single point responsibility completely covering the activities and services in respect of all the equipment & works specified and covered under the specifications and read in conjunction with “**Scope of Supply**” elaborated elsewhere. |

### 3.0 **QUALIFYING REQUIREMENTS FOR BIDDERS.**

The bidder who wishes to participate in the bidding shall meet the Qualifying Requirements stipulated hereunder:

#### 3.1 **Technical Criteria:**

3.1.1 The bidder should be a manufacturer of IBR certified valve(s) or an authorised ‘dealer’ /‘distributor’ / ‘channel partner’ / ‘subsidiary’ of the manufacturer of IBR certified valve(s).

3.1.2 The bidder should have supplied ‘motor operated valve(s) with actuator’ of size 8”(200NB) or above with rating of ‘at least 300 class’ to any industry.

3.1.3 The bidder should have executed order(s) for supply of “**IBR certified valve(s) with / without actuators to any industry**” during the preceding seven (07) years,prior to the date of Techno-Commercial bid opening, in any of the following manner:

i) Single order with executed value not less than **Rs. 77 Lakhs.**

OR

ii) Two orders with executed value not less than **Rs. 48 Lakhs each.**

OR

iii) Three orders with executed value not less than **Rs. 38 Lakhs each**

Notes for Technical Criteria:

1. The word “Executed” mentioned above means that the bidder should have achieved the criteria specified above, even if the total contract is started earlier and/or is not completed/closed.

2. In case of orders under execution, the value of work executed prior to the date of Techno-Commercial bid opening duly certified by bidder’s client shall be considered acceptable.

3. Reference work executed by the bidder as a sub-contractor

may also be considered provided the certificate issued by main contractor is duly certified by owner specifying the scope of work executed by the sub-contractor in support of qualifying requirements.

4. For arriving at the executed value of work specified above, basic amount only shall be considered. In case contract is inclusive of taxes, bidder should provide the break - up of basic value and taxes

### 3.2 **Financial Criteria:**

3.2.1 The Average Annual Turnover of the Bidder **should not be less than Rs. 96 Lakh (Rupees Ninety-Six lakh only) during the preceding three (3) completed financial years** as on the date of Techno-Commercial bid opening.

3.2.2 In case the bidder does not satisfy the financial criteria, stipulated at Cl. 3.2.1 above on its own, its Holding Company would be required to meet the stipulated turnover requirements at Cl. 3.2.1 above, provided that the net worth of such Holding Company as on the last day of the preceding financial year is at least equal to or more than the paid-up share capital of the Holding Company. In such an event, the bidder would be required to furnish along with its Techno-Commercial bid, a Letter of Undertaking from the Holding Company, supported by Board Resolution, as per the format enclosed in the bid documents, pledging unconditional and irrevocable financial support for the execution of the Contract by the bidder in case of award.

3.2.3 In case the bidder is not able to furnish its audited financial statements on stand-alone entity basis, the unaudited unconsolidated financial statements of the bidder can be considered acceptable provided the bidder further furnishes the following documents for substantiation of its qualification.

Copies of the unaudited unconsolidated financial statements of the bidder along with copies of the Audited consolidated financial statements of its Holding Company.

A Certificate from the CEO/CFO of the Holding Company, as per the format enclosed in the bidding documents, stating that the unaudited unconsolidated financial statements form part of the Consolidated Annual Report of the

company.

3.2.4 In cases where audited results for the last preceding financial year as on the date of Techno-Commercial bid opening are not available, the financial results certified by a practicing Chartered Accountant shall be considered acceptable. In case, Bidder is not able to submit the Certificate from practicing Chartered Accountant certifying its financial parameters, the audited results of three consecutive financial years preceding the last financial year shall be considered for evaluating the financial parameters. Further, a Certificate would be required from the CEO/CFO as per the format enclosed in the bidding documents stating that the Financial results of the Company are under audit as on the date of Techno-Commercial bid opening and the Certificate from the practicing Chartered Accountant certifying the financial parameters is not available.

**Notes:-**

1. Other income shall not be considered for arriving at annual turnover.
2. "Holding Company" and "Subsidiary Company" shall have the meaning ascribed to them as per Companies Act of India, in vogue.
3. Net worth means the sum total of the paid up share capital and free reserves. Free reserve means all reserves credited out of the profits and share premium account but does not include reserves credited out of the revaluation of the assets, write back of depreciation provision and amalgamation. Further, any debit balance of Profit and Loss account and miscellaneous expenses to the extent not adjusted or written off, if any, shall be reduced from reserves and surplus.

4.0 NTPC reserves the right to reject any or all bids or cancel / withdraw the Invitation for Bids/NIT without assigning any reason whatsoever and in such case no bidder / intending bidder shall have any claim arising out of such action.

5.0 Issuance of bid documents to any Bidder shall not construe that such bidder is considered to be qualified. Bids shall be submitted online and opened at the address given below in the presence of Bidder's representatives who choose to attend the bid opening.

6.0 Transfer of Bidding Documents purchased by one intending Bidder to another is not permissible.
