Sipat Super Thermal Power Station is located at <u>Sipat</u> in <u>Bilaspur district</u> in state of <u>Chhattisgarh</u>. The power plant is one of the <u>coal</u> based power plants of <u>NTPC</u>. The coal for the power plant is sourced from Dipika Mines of <u>South Eastern Coalfields Limited</u>.

The project has an installed capacity of 2980 MW consisting of two stages, stage one which got commissioned late was of 3 units of 660 MW each involving super-critical boilers technology and stage two consisted of 2 units of 500 MW each.
