I. NTPC invites on-line bids on **Single Stage Two Envelope Bidding basis** (Envelope-I: Techno-commercial Bid & Envelope-II: Price Bid) from Eligible Bidders for R&M works in Stage-II Chimney at Ramagundam super Thermal Power Station as per Scope of Work mentioned hereinafter.

II. **Brief Scope of Work**

Dismantling of CI caps and installation of new CI caps for Chimneys of Unit 4, 5 & 6. The work also includes Chipping & Repair works if any, under the damaged CI caps, supply & fixing of new CI caps as per the drawing including grouting, patch works with cement mortar/CC/brick work, Glass wool packing, acid resistant mortar fill, asbestos mill board sheet etc

The detailed scope and description of work covered under this package has been specified in relevant clause of Detailed Technical Specification.

- IV. All bids must be accompanied by **Tender Fees (Cost of Bidding Documents) and Bid Security**. Regarding ‘Bid Security’, Bidders are required to accept General Technical Evaluation (GTE) conditions on-line while submitting their bid.

Any bid without an acceptable Tender Fees (through online GePNIC portal) and Bid Security shall be rejected by Employer as being non-responsive and shall not be opened. For details please refer ITB/ BDS Clause.

V. **Qualifying Requirements for Bidders:**

	<p>1. The word "Executed" mentioned above means that the bidder should have achieved the criteria specified above, even if the total contract is started earlier and/or is not completed/closed.</p> <p>2. In case of orders under execution, the value of work executed prior to the date of Techno-Commercial bid opening duly certified by bidder's client shall be considered acceptable.</p> <p>3. Reference work executed by the bidder as a sub-contractor may also be considered provided the certificate issued by main contractor is duly certified by owner specifying the scope of work executed by the sub-contractor in support of qualifying requirements.</p> <p>4. For arriving at the executed value of work specified above, basic amount only shall be considered. 2.0	<u>Financial Criteria</u>
2.1	The Average Annual Financial Turnover (AATO) of the bidder during preceding three (03) consecutive financial years as on the date of Techno - Commercial bid opening should not be less than Rs. 184.57 Lakhs (Rupees One Hundred Eighty-Four Lakhs Fifty-Seven Thousand Only)
2.2	In case the Bidder does not satisfy the financial criteria, stipulated at Cl. No. 2.1 above on its own, its Holding Company would be required to meet the stipulated turnover requirements at Cl. No. 2.1 above, provided that the Net Worth of such Holding Company as on the last day of the preceding financial year is at least equal to or more than the paid-up share capital of the Holding Company. In such an event, the Bidder would be required to furnish along with its Techno-Commercial bid, a Letter of Undertaking from the Holding Company, supported by the Holding Company's Board Resolution, as per the format enclosed in the Bid Documents, pledging unconditional & irrevocable financial support for the execution of the contract by the bidder in case of award.
2.3	In case the Bidder does not satisfy the financial criteria, stipulated at Cl. No. 2.1 above on its own, its Holding Company would be required to meet the stipulated turnover requirements at Cl. No. 2.1 above, provided that the Net Worth of such Holding Company as on the last day of the preceding financial year is at least equal to or more than the paid-up share capital of the Holding Company. In such an event, the Bidder would be required to furnish along with its Techno-Commercial bid, a Letter of Undertaking from the Holding Company, supported by the Holding Company's Board Resolution, as per the format enclosed in the Bid Documents, pledging unconditional & irrevocable financial support for the execution of the contract by the bidder in case of award.
2.4	In cases where audited results for the last financial year as on the date of Techno-commercial bid opening are not available, the financial results certified by a practicing Chartered Accountant shall be considered acceptable. In case, Bidder is not able to submit the certificate from practicing Chartered Accountant certifying its financial parameters, the audited results for the three (03) consecutive financial years preceding the last financial year shall be considered for evaluating the financial parameters. Further, a certificate would be required from CEO/CFO as per the format enclosed in the bidding document stating that the financial results of the company are under audit as on the date of Techno-commercial bid opening and the certificate from the practicing Chartered Accountant certifying financial parameters is not available.

	Notes for Clause 2.0 above:
(i)	Net worth means the sum total of the paid-up share capital and free reserves. Free reserve means all reserves credited out of the profits and share premium account but does not include reserves credited out of the revaluation of the assets, write back of depreciation provision and amalgamation. Further any debit balance of Profit and Loss account and miscellaneous expenses to the extent not adjusted or written off, if any, shall be reduced from reserves and surplus.
(ii)	Other income shall not be considered for arriving at annual turnover figures.
(iii)	“Holding Company” and “Subsidiary Company” shall have the meaning ascribed to them as per Companies Act of India.

- VI. Notwithstanding anything stated above, the Employer reserves the right to assess the capabilities and capacity of the Bidder/ his collaborators / associates/ subsidiaries / group companies to perform the contract, should the circumstances warrant such assessment in the overall interest of the Employer.
- VII. NTPC reserves the right to reject any or all bids or cancel/withdraw the NIT for the subject package without assigning any reason whatsoever and in such case no bidder/intending bidder shall have any claim arising out of such action.
- VIII. The bidding document is available online. A complete set of Bidding Documents may be downloaded by any interested Bidder from the NTPC tender website <https://eprocurementpc.nic.in>. The Bidder would be required to register on the website. First time users are required to register themselves on NTPC tender website (<https://eprocurementpc.nic.in>) after filling up the required details. Users whose email address has not been linked to a vendor code allotted by NTPC/ first time users not allotted any vendor code by NTPC, should send a copy of the registration details to the e-mail address specified in this NIT under Address for Communication with following details at least three working days prior to Technical Opening Date:

- IX. Issuance of bid documents to any bidder shall not construe that such bidder is considered to be qualified. Bids shall be submitted online and opened at the address given below in the presence of Bidder’s representatives who choose to attend the bid opening.
- X. Transfer of Bidding Documents purchased by one intending Bidder to another is not permissible.
- XI. 'Class-I local suppliers' only are eligible to participate in this tender, as defined in the bidding documents/ Public Procurement (Preference to Make in India), Order 2017 and its subsequent amendments/ revisions issued by DPIIT. The bidders may apprise themselves of the relevant provisions of bidding documents in this regard before submission of their bids.

XII Any 'Bidder from a country which shares a land border with India', as specified in the Bidding Documents, will be eligible to bid in this tender only if bidder is registered with the Competent Authority as mentioned in the Bidding Documents.
