1. The applicant should be "Limestone Mine(s) Owner" / "Limestone Mine(s) Lessee" with the mine(s) located in India.

- **2.** The applicant should be "Limestone Trader/ Supplier/ bulk user", who sources limestone from backup mine(s) located in India.
- **3.** The applicant should have executed the purchase order(s) for supply of Limestone with CaO (Calcium Oxide) content of at least 47%, in the preceding five (05) years prior to the date of application.

C Documents to be submitted as proof of meeting the stipulated Qualifying Requirements:

- QR-1: Copy of valid Mine(s) ownership/ Permission/ Letter of Intent/ agreement from competent government authority & Copy of registration under Rule 45 of MCDR 1988
 Indian Bureau of Mines (Ministry of Mines).
- **ii. QR-2**: Applicant (Trader/ Supplier/ bulk user) shall provide letter of authority for supply of limestone from the concerned backup Limestone mine owner/ lessee, for the enlistment period*/ Trading license under concerned Mining circle (if applicable).

2. Testing Requirement:

- i. The vendor to sample each lot and do testing for all the parameters in a government recognized laboratory/ NABL accredited laboratory/ Global Environment & Mining Services, Bangalore/ SGS House, Mumbai, at his own cost and communicate the result to NTPC prior to starting dispatch of that lot. The material will be loaded for dispatch after clearance from NTPC based on compliance to the limits /value specified above at point no. 1(a) to 1(d) for all the four parameters.
- ii. The material will be tested at NTPC on arrival through random sampling (either directly or through an authorized agency appointed by NTPC) once in a week on a date and time (as mutually agreed between site & vendor) specified by the individual station where the vendor may choose to send their representative to witness the sampling and analysis.
- iii. Testing at NTPC site to be done for specific parameters CaO & MgO and other Parameter through NTPC facilities / authorized agency appointed by NTPC.
