- 1. Bid reserved for Make In India products: : Procurement under this bid is reserved for purchase from Class 1 local supplier as defined in public procurement (Preference to Make in India), Order 2017 as amended from time to time and its subsequent Orders/Notifications issued by concerned Nodal Ministry for specific Goods/Products. However, eligible micro and small enterprises will be allowed to participate. The minimum local content to qualify as a class 1 local supplier is denoted in the bid document. All bidders must upload a certificate from the OEM regarding the percentage of the local content and the details of locations at which the local value addition is made along with their bid, failing which the bid is liable to be rejected. In case the bid value is more than Rs 10 Crore, the declaration relating to percentage of local content shall be certified by the statutory auditor or cost auditor, if the OEM is a company and by a practicing cost accountant or a chartered accountant for OEMs other than companies as per the Public Procurement (preference to Make-in -India) order 2017 dated 04.06.2020 . In case Buyer has selected Purchase preference to Micro and Small Enterprises clause in the bid, the same will get precedence over this clause.
- 2. Purchase preference to Micro and Small Enterprises (MSEs): Purchase preference will be given to MSEs as defined in Public Procurement Policy for Micro and Small Enterprises (MSEs) Order, 2012 dated 23.03.2012 issued by Ministry of Micro, Small and Medium Enterprises and its subsequent Orders/Notifications issued by concerned Ministry. If the bidder wants to avail the Purchase preference, the bidder must be the manufacturer of the offered product in case of bid for supply of goods. Traders are excluded from the purview of Public Procurement Policy for Micro and Small Enterprises. In respect of bid for Services, the bidder must be the Service provider of the offered Service. Relevant documentary evidence in this regard shall be uploaded along with the bid in respect of the offered product or service. If L-1 is not an MSE and MSE Seller (s) has/have quoted price within L-1+ 15% (Selected by Buyer)of margin of purchase preference /price band defined in relevant policy, such Seller shall be given opportunity to match L-1 price and contract will be awarded for 40%(selected by Buyer) percentage of total QUANTITY. 1. Generic

OPTION CLAUSE: The Purchaser reserves the right to increase or decrease the quantity to be ordered up to 25 percent of bid quantity at the time of placement of contract. The purchaser also reserves the right to increase the ordered quantity by up to 25% of the contracted quantity during the currency of the contract at the contracted rates. Bidders are bound to accept the orders accordingly.

2. Generic

Bidder shall submit the following documents along with their bid for Vendor Code Creation:

- a. Copy of PAN Card.
- b. Copy of GSTIN.
- c. Copy of Cancelled Cheque.
- d. Copy of EFT Mandate duly certified by Bank.

3. Generic

1.0 Qualifying Requirements:

The bidder who wishes to participate in the bidding shall meet the Qualifying Requirement s stipulated hereunder:

1.1: Technical Criteria:

1.1.1 The bidder should be a manufacturer of Sodium Bicarbonate.

OR

1.1.2 The bidder should be a Supplier/ dealer/ representative of Sodium bicarbonate manu facturer(s). Bidder should provide the authorization letter from respective manufacturer(s) for supply of Sodium Bicarbonate.

1.2 Financial Criteria:

- 1.2.1 The Average Annual Financial Turnover of the Bidder during the last three (03) financial years as on the date of Techno-commercial bid opening should not be less than INR 3805 Lakhs (Rupees thirty-Eight Crore Five lakhs only).
- 1.2.2 The Net Worth of the Bidder should not be less than 100% of the Bidder's Paid up Share capital as on the last day of the preceding financial year. In case the Bidder meets the requirement of Net Worth based on the strength of its Subsidiary(ies) and/or Holding Company and/or Subsidiaries of its Holding Company wherever applicable, the Net Worth of the Bidder and its Subsidiary(ies) and/or Holding Company, in combined manner should not be less than 100% of their total paid up share capital. However, individually, their Net Worth should not be less than 75% of their respective paid-up share capitals.
- 1.2.3 Net worth in combined manner shall be calculated as follows:

Net worth (combined) = (X1+X2+X3) / (Y1+Y2+Y3) X 100% where X1, X2, X3 are individual Net Worth which should not be less than 75% of the respective paid-up share capitals and Y1, Y2, Y3 are individual paid up share capitals.

- 1.2.4 In case the bidder is not able to furnish its audited financial statements on standa lone entity basis, the unaudited unconsolidated financial statements of the bidder can be considered acceptable provided the bidder furnishes the following further document s on substantiation of its qualification:
- a. Copies of the unaudited unconsolidated financial statements of the bidder along with copies of the audited consolidated financial statements of the Holding Company.
- b. A certificate from the CEO/CFO of the Holding Company as per the format enclosed in the bid documents stating that the unaudited unconsolidated financial statements for m part of the consolidated annual report of the company.
- 1.2.5 In case a Bidder does not satisfy the financial criteria stipulated in Clause 1.2.1 a bove on its own, Its Holding Company would require to meet the stipulated turnover re quirements at Clause 1.2.1 above, provided that the net worth of such Holding Company as on the last day of the preceding financial year is at least equal to or more than the paid-up share capital of the Holding company. In such an event, the Bidder should be required to furnish along with its Techno-Commercial bid, a letter of undertaking from its Holding Company, supported by Board Resolution of the Holding Company, as per the format enclosed in the bidding documents, pledging unconditional and irrevocable financial support for the execution of the Contract by the Bidder in case of award.
- 1.2.6 In case where audited results for the last financial year as on the date of Techno Commercial Bid Opening are not available, the financial results certified by a practicing Chartered Accountant shall be considered acceptable. In case, Bidder is not able to sub mit the Certificate from practicing Chartered Accountant certifying its financial parameters, the audited results of three consecutive financial years preceding the last financial year shall be considered for evaluating the financial parameters. Further, a certificate would be required from the CEO/CFO as per the format enclosed in the bidding docume nts stating that the financial results of the Company are under audit as on the date of T echno-Commercial Bid Opening and the Certificate from the practicing Chartered Accountant certifying the financial parameters is not available.

Notes:

- i. "Holding Company" and "Subsidiary" shall have the meaning ascribed to them as per Companies Act of India, in vouge.
- ii. Net worth means the sum total of the paid-up share capital and free reserves. Free reserves means all reserves credited out of the profits and share premium account but do not include reserves credited out of the revaluation of the assets, write back of depreciation provision and amalgamation. Further, any debit balance of Profit and Loss account and miscellaneous expenses to the extent not adjusted or written off, if any, s hall be reduced from reserves and surplus.
- iii. While computing the annual turnover other Income shall not be considered.
- iv. For annual turnover indicated in foreign currency, the exchange rate as on 7 day s prior to the date of techno-commercial bid opening shall be used

Notes-

a. NTPC reserves the right to reject any or all bids or cancel / withdraw the Invitation for Bids/NIT without assigning any reason whatsoever and in such case no bidder / intending b idder shall have any claim arising out of such action.

b. Only PO submitted along with bid shall be considered for evaluation of Qualifying requirement.

Evaluation Criteria:

Item-wise

Bid evaluation shall be based on landed cost i.e FOR site basis.

Bidders have to quote rate inclusive of GST in BOQ

Total Quantity shall be Split among two bidders in the ratio of 60:40Hence , 60% quantity will be procured from one vendor and rest 40% of quantity will be procured from next Eligible vendor

The following procedure shall be followed for Evaluation:

Case I:-

- i) Among all qualified and substantially responsive bids, the lowest evaluated bid will be termed as L1.
- ii) If L1 bid is from an MSE, then 60% of Tendered Quantity shall be awarded to L1.
- iii) For Balance 40% Quantity, all bidders (irrespective of type of bidder i.e MSEs or Non-MSEs) will be invited to match the lowest evaluated bid (L1) price. The 40% Quantity shall be awarded to bidder matching the L1 price with preference as per their ranking in original bid.

For example if L2, L3, L4 matched the L1 price then 40% qty will be awarded to L2 bidde r (irrespective of type of bidder i.e MSEs or Non-MSEs).

- If L2 bidder not agrees to match L1 price and L3, L4 agrees to match the price then 40% qty will be awarded to L3 bidder (irrespective of type of bidder i.e MSEs or Non-MSEs) and so on.
- iv) If none of the bidders agree to match the lowest evaluated bid price then balance 40 % quantity shall be awarded to L-1 vendor i.e 100% quantity shall be awarded to L-1 vendor.
- v) For the purpose of matching of lowest evaluated bid (L1) price, the supplier would hav e to necessarily reduce all components of the quoted price on pro-rata basis. The reducti on should not apply on the evaluation loading on account of functional guarantees and o ther loadings (if any, which are not dependent on quoted price). Further, the Contract sh all be awarded on such revised/ reduced quoted price. The summation of the revised / re duced quoted price and the evaluation loading on account of functional guarantees and other loadings (if any) shall be equal to the lowest evaluated bid (L1) price.

Case II:-

- i) Among all qualified and substantially responsive bids, the lowest evaluated bid will be te rmed as L1.
- ii) If L1 Bid is **NOT** from an MSE. Then 60% Quantity shall be offered for L1 Bidder.
- iii) For Balance 40% Quantity
- a) the lowest evaluated bidder among the MSEs, will be invited to match the lowest evaluated bid (L1) price subject to MSE's evaluated bid price falling within the range of fiftee n (15%) of the lowest evaluated bid (L1) price (i.e L1+15%) and the 40% Quantity shall be awarded to such MSEs subject to matching the lowest evaluated bid (L1) price. In case such lowest eligible MSEs fails to match the lowest evaluated bid (L1) price, the MSEs

with the next higher evaluated bid within the range of fifteen (15%) of the lowest evaluated bid (L1) price (i.e L1+15%) shall be invited to match the lowest evaluated bid (L1) price and so on and 40% Quantity shall be awarded accordingly.

- b) if none of the MSEs bidder falls within the Price Range of L1+15% or non of MSEs with in the price range of L1+15% agrees to meet the L-1 price, then L2 Bidder (irrespective of type of bidder i.e MSEs or Non-MSEs) will be invited to match the lowest evaluated bid (L1) price. The 40% Quantity shall be awarded to such bidder subject to matching the lowest evaluated bid (L1) price. In case such lowest eligible Bidder fails to match the lowest evaluated bid (L1) price, the bidder (irrespective of type of bidder i.e MSEs or Non-MSEs) with the next higher evaluated bid shall be invited to match the lowest evaluated bid (L1) price and so on and 40% Quantity shall be awarded accordingly.
- iv) If none of the bidders agree to match the lowest evaluated bid price then balance 40 % quantity shall be awarded to L-1 vendor i.e 100% quantity shall be awarded to L-1 vendor.
- v) For the purpose of matching of lowest evaluated bid (L1) price, the supplier would hav e to necessarily reduce all components of the quoted price on pro-rata basis. The reducti on should not apply on the evaluation loading on account of functional guarantees and o ther loadings (if any, which are not dependent on quoted price). Further, the Contract sh all be awarded on such revised/ reduced quoted price. The summation of the revised / re duced quoted price and the evaluation loading on account of functional guarantees and other loadings (if any) shall be equal to the lowest evaluated bid (L1) price.

- 8. Seeking sample with bid or approval of samples during bid evaluation process.
- 9. Mandating foreign / international certifications even in case of existence of Indian Standards without specifying equivalent Indian Certification / standards.
- 10. Seeking experience from specific organization / department / institute only or from foreign / export experience.
- 11. Creating bid for items from irrelevant categories.
- 12. Incorporating any clause against the MSME policy and Preference to Make in India Policy.
- 13. Reference of conditions published on any external site or reference to external documents/clauses.
- 14. Asking for any Tender fee / Bid Participation fee / Auction fee in case of Bids / Forward Auction, as the case may be.

Further, if any seller has any objection/grievance against these additional clauses or otherwise on any aspect of this bid, they can raise their representation against the same by using the Representation window provided in the bid details field in Seller dashboard after logging in as a seller within 4 days of bid publication on GeM. Buyer is duty bound to reply to all such representations and would not be allowed to open bids if he fails to reply to such representations.
