Bid reserved for Make In India products: : Procurement under this bid is reserved for purchase from Class 1 local supplier as defined in public procurement (Preference to Make in India), Order 2017 as amended from time to time and its subsequent Orders/Notifications issued by concerned Nodal Ministry for specific Goods/Products. 1.0 NTPC Limited (NTPC) invites online bids on "Single Stage Two Envelope Bi dding Basis" from eligible bidders for aforesaid package, as per the scope of work briefly mentioned hereinafter.

2.0 BRIEF SCOPE OF WORK

The scope of the proposal is "Supply of Fluidizing Blower Assembly (Blowers with Motors and Heaters) for NTPC Korba and Deployment of Engineer or Supervisor" and shall be on the basis of single point responsibility completely covering the activities and services covered under the specifications and read in conjunction with "Scope of Supply" elaborated elsewhere.

3.0 QUALIFYING REQUIREMENTS FOR BIDDERS

The bidder who wishes to participate in the bidding shall meet the Qualifying R equirements stipulated hereunder:

1.0	Technical Criteria :

Notes for Technical Criteria:

- 2. In case of orders under execution, the value of the order execute d prior to the date of Techno-Commercial bid opening duly certified by bidder's client shall be considered acceptable.
- 3. For arriving at the executed value of order specified above, basic amount only shall be considered. In case order is inclusive of taxe s, bidder should provide the break up of basic value and taxes.
- 4. Latest annual report OR NSIC / SSI / MSME registration certificate / BIS license /ISO certificate / MDCC/ any other statutory docume nt as a proof of being manufacturer of the required material.

1.2 | Financial criteria :

1.2.1 The Average Annual Turnover of the Bidder, should not be less than Rs. **84 Lakh (Rupees Eighty-four lakh only)** during the preceding three (3) completed financial years prior to the date of Techno-Commercial bid opening.

In case, Bidder is not able to submit the Certificate from practicing Chartered Accountant certifying its financial parameters, the audited results of three consecutive financial years preceding the last financial year shall be considered for evaluating the financial parameters. Further, a Certificate would be required from the CEO/CFO as per the format enclosed in the bidding documents stating that the financial results of the Company are under audit as on the date of Techno-Commercial bid opening and the Certificate from the practicing Chartered Accountant certifying the financial parameters is not available.

Free reserve means all reserves credited out of the profits and share premium account but does not include reserves credited out of the revaluation of the assets, write back of depreci ation provision and amalgamation. Further, any debit balance of Profit and Loss account and miscellaneous expenses to the extent not adjusted or written off, if any, shall be reduced from re serves and surplus.
