Bid reserved for Make In India products: : Procurement under this bid is reserved for purchase from Class 1 local supplier as defined in public procurement (Preference to Make in India), Order 2017 as amended from time to time and its subsequent Orders/Notifications issued by concerned Nodal Ministry for specific Goods/Products. However, eligible micro and small enterprises will be allowed to participate. The minimum local content to qualify as a class 1 local supplier is denoted in the bid document. All bidders must upload a certificate from the OEM regarding the percentage of the local content and the details of locations at which the local value addition is made along with their bid, failing which the bid is liable to be rejected. In case the bid value is more than Rs 10 Crore, the declaration relating to percentage of local content shall be certified by the statutory auditor or cost

auditor, if the OEM is a company and by a practicing cost accountant or a chartered accountant for OEMs other than companies as per the Public Procurement (preference to Make-in -India) order 2017 dated 04.06.2020 . In case Buyer has selected Purchase preference to Micro and Small Enterprises clause in the bid, the same will get precedence over this clause.

2. Purchase preference to Micro and Small Enterprises (MSEs): Purchase preference will be given to MSEs as defined in Public Procurement Policy for Micro and Small Enterprises (MSEs) Order, 2012 dated 23.03.2012 issued by Ministry of Micro, Small and Medium Enterprises and its subsequent Orders/Notifications issued by concerned Ministry. If the bidder wants to avail the Purchase preference, the bidder must be the manufacturer of the offered product in case of bid for supply of goods. Traders are excluded from the purview of Public Procurement Policy for Micro and Small Enterprises. In respect of bid for Services, the bidder must be the Service provider of the offered Service. Relevant documentary evidence in this regard shall be uploaded along with the bid in respect of the offered product or service. If L-1 is not an MSE and MSE Seller (s) has/have quoted price within L-1+ 15% (Selected by Buyer)of margin of purchase preference /price band defined in relevant policy, such Seller shall be given opportunity to match L-1 price and contract will be awarded for 25%(selected by Buyer) percentage of total QUANTITY. Qualifying Requirements:

1.0 Work Criteria:

1.1 The bidder should be a manufacturer of Sodium Chlorite,

OR

1.2 The bidder should be an authorized Supplier/ dealer/ representative of Sodium chlorite manufacturer(s). Bidder should provide the authorization letter from respective manufacturer(s) for supply of Sodium chlorite.

Notes for Technical Criteria 1.1:

1. In support of the technical criteria of manufacturing any of the following documents may be submitted:

Valid factory license or consent to operate from any Central / state Government / statutory body such as Pollution Control Board or NSIC registration or valid NSF certificate or any other document from any statut ory authority with the mention of manufacturing of sodium chlorite /CIO2 precursor.

2.0 Financial Criteria:

- 2.1 The Average Annual Financial Turnover of the Bidder during the last three (03) financial years as on the date of Techno-commercial bid opening should not be less than INR 2229 Lakhs (Rupees twenty two crore twenty nine lakhs only).
- 2.2 The Net Worth of the Bidder should not be less than 100% of the Bidder's paid up share capital as on t he last day of the preceding financial year. In case the Bidder meets the requirement of Net Worth based on the strength of its Subsidiary(ies) and/ or Holding Company and/ or Subsidiaries of its Holding Company wherever applicable, the Net Worth of the Bidder and its Subsidiary(ies) and/ or Holding Company, in combined manner should not be less than 100% of their total paid up share capital. However, individually, their Net Worth should not be less than 75% of their respective paid up share capitals.

Net worth in combined manner shall be calculated as follows:

Net worth (combined) = (X1+X2+X3) / (Y1+Y2+Y3) X 100% where X1, X2, X3 are

individual Net Worth which should not be less than 75% of the respective paid up share capitals and Y1,Y 2,Y3 are individual paid up share capitals.

- 2.3 In case the bidder is not able to furnish its audited financial statements on standalone entity basis, the unaudited unconsolidated financial statements of the bidder can be considered acceptable provided the bidder furnishes the following further documents on substantiation of its qualification:
- Copies of the unaudited unconsolidated financial statements of the bidder along with copies of the audited consolidated financial statements of the Holding Company.
- b. A certificate from the CEO/CFO of the Holding Company as per the format enclosed in the bid docum ents stating that the unaudited unconsolidated financial statements form part of the consolidated ann ual report of the company.
- 2.4 In case a Bidder does not satisfy the financial criteria stipulated in Clause 2.1 above on its own, Its Hol ding Company would require to meet the stipulated turnover requirements at Clause 2.1 above, provided that the net worth of such Holding Company as on the last day of the preceding financial year is at least e qual to or more than the paid-up share capital of the Holding company. In such an event, the Bidder shoul d be required to furnish along with its Techno-Commercial bid, a letter of undertaking from its Holding Company, supported by Board Resolution of the Holding Company, as per the format enclosed in the biddin g documents, pledging unconditional and irrevocable financial support for the execution of the Contract b y the Bidder in case of award.

2.5 In case where audited results for the last financial year as on the date of Techno Commercial Bid Ope ning are not available, the financial results certified by a practicing Chartered Accountant shall be conside red acceptable. In case, Bidder is not able to submit the Certificate from practicing Chartered Accountant certifying its financial parameters, the audited results of three consecutive financial years preceding the I ast financial year shall be considered for evaluating the financial parameters. Further, a certificate would be required from the CEO/CFO as per the format enclosed in the bidding documents stating that the financial results of the Company are under audit as on the date of Techno-Commercial Bid Opening and the Certificate from the practicing Chartered Accountant certifying the financial parameters is not available.

Notes for 2.0

- 1. "Holding Company" and "Subsidiary" shall have the meaning ascribed to them as per Companies Act of India, in vogue.
- 2.0 Net worth means the sum total of the paid-up share capital and free reserves. Free reserves means all reserves credited out of the profits and share premium account but do not include reserves credited out of the revaluation of the assets, write back of depreciation provision and amalgamation. Further, any debit balance of Profit and Loss account and miscellaneous expenses to the extent not adjusted or written off, if any, shall be reduced from reserves and surplus.
- 3.0 While computing the annual turnover other Income shall not be considered.

Notes-

- a. NTPC reserves the right to reject any or all bids or cancel / withdraw the Invitation for Bids/NIT without assigning any reason whatsoever and in such case no bidder / intending bidder shall have any cla im arising out of such action.
- b. Issuance of bid documents to any Bidder shall not construe that such bidder is consider ed to be qualified. Bids shall be submitted online and opened at the address given below in the pr esence of Bidder's representatives who choose to attend the bid opening.

- 12. Incorporating any clause against the MSME policy and Preference to Make in India Policy.

- 13. Reference of conditions published on any external site or reference to external documents/clauses.
- 14. Asking for any Tender fee / Bid Participation fee / Auction fee in case of Bids / Forward Auction, as the case may be.

Further, if any seller has any objection/grievance against these additional clauses or otherwise on any aspect of this bid, they can raise their representation against the same by using the Representation window provided in the bid details field in Seller dashboard after logging in as a seller within 4 days of bid publication on GeM. Buyer is duty bound to reply to all such representations and would not be allowed to open bids if he fails to reply to such representations.
