Purchase preference will be given to MSEs having valid Udyam Registration and whose credentials are validated online through Udyam Registration portal as defined in Public Procurement Policy for Micro and Small Enterprises (MSEs) Order, 2012 dated 23.03.2012 issued by Ministry of Micro, Small and Medium Enterprises and its subsequent Orders/Notifications issued by concerned Ministry. If the bidder wants to avail themselves of the Purchase preference the bidder must be the manufacturer / OEM of the offered product on GeM. Traders are excluded from the purview of Public Procurement Policy for Micro and Small Enterprises and hence resellers offering products manufactured by some other OEM are not eligible for any purchase preference. In respect of bid for Services, the bidder must be the Service provider of the offered Service. 1. Generic

OPTION CLAUSE: The buyer can increase or decrease the contract quantity or contract duration up to 25 percent at the time of issue of the contract. However, once the contract is issued, contract quantity or contract duration can only be increased up to 25 percent. Bidders are bound to accept the revised quantity or duration.

1.0 Technical Criteria

- (a) Bidder should have successfully executed the work of "Supply, Installation and Commissioning of CCTV system" or "Maintenance contract work of CCTV system" at Plant areas in any NTPC stations or its JV's, subsidiaries /Semi Govt./ PSU/ SEBs/ Private Power stations/ Refineries/ Process Industries during last seven (07) years as on the date of techno-Commercial bid opening (specified in Original NIT) having minimum contract value as indicated below: -

1.1 One executed order costing not less than Rs. 15.94 Lakh

OR

1.2 Two executed orders costing not less than Rs. 09.96 Lakh each

OR

1.3 Three executed orders costing not less than Rs. 07.97 Lakh each

2.0 Financial Criteria

- 2.1 The average annual turnover of the bidder in the three preceding financial years, as on the date of techno-Commercial bid opening (specified in Original NIT) shall not be less than Rs19.92 Lakh.

- 2.2 In case where audited results for the last preceding financial year as on the date of techno-commercial bid opening (specified in Original NIT) are not available, the financial results certified by a practicing chartered accountant shall be considered acceptable. In case, Bidder is not able to submit the certificate from practicing chartered Accountant certifying its financial parameters, the audited results of three consecutive financial years preceding the last financial years shall be considered for evaluating the financial parameters. Further, a certificate would be required from CEO/CFO as per the format enclosed in the bidding document stating that the financial result of the company is under audit as on the date of Techno-Commercial bid opening and the certificate from the practicing Chartered Accountant certifying financial parameters is not available.

Notes:-

- a) Word executed means the bidder should have achieved the criteria specified in the QR even if the contract has been started earlier and/or is not completed/closed and the same shall be supported by the documentary evidence.
- b) In case of orders under execution, the value of work executed prior to the date of Techno-Commercial bid opening duly certified by bidder's client shall be considered acceptable.
- c) Reference work executed by the bidder as a sub-contractor may also be considered provided that

certificate issued by main contractor is duly certified by owner specifying the scope of work executed by the sub-contractor in support of qualifying requirements.

d) For arriving at the executed value of work specified above, basic amount only shall be considered. In case contract is inclusive of taxes, bidder should provide the break-up of basic value and taxes.

e) Other income will not be considered in evaluation of turnover.

Requirement of PAN, GST Registration, valid PF code registration number, ESIC registration, T&P and equipment necessary for movement and installation of material (if applicable) are to be kept under general conditions of contract. Intending bidder shall be required to submit/upload (online) the following documents along with their technical bid (as applicable).

b) QR Evaluation Checklist (To be filled by Bidder)

c) Audited Annual Report (Balance Sheet and Profit & Loss Account) of last three financial years/any other documents showing Turnover

d) QR related documents in line with clause no. 31 of ITB (also refer Annexures) and as per the above Qualifying Requirement.

e) Firm's documents like Memorandum & Articles of association/ Partnership/ Proprietorship Deed/Certificate of Incorporation etc., with latest changes if any.

f) Income Tax Permanent Account Number (PAN), GST Numbers.

Note: 1. 2. 4. Clause 31 of ITB, Annexure-B (Undertaking from Third Party Inspection Agency) is applicable for PROPRIETORSHIP FIRMS, PARTNERSHIP FIRMS & COMPANIES AS WELL.

9. Mandating foreign / international certifications even in case of existence of Indian Standards without specifying equivalent Indian Certification / standards.
10. Seeking experience from specific organization / department / institute only or from foreign / export experience
11. Creating bid for items from irrelevant categories.
12. Incorporating any clause against the MSME policy and Preference to Make in India Policy.
13. Reference of conditions published on any external site or reference to external documents/clauses.
14. Asking for any Tender fee / Bid Participation fee / Auction fee in case of Bids / Forward Auction, as the case may be.
15. Any ATC clause in contravention with GeM GTC Clause 4 (xiii)(h) will be invalid. In case of multiple L1 bidders against a service bid, the buyer shall place the Contract by selection of a bidder amongst the L-1 bidders through a Random Algorithm executed by GeM system.

Further, if any seller has any objection/grievance against these additional clauses or otherwise on any aspect of this bid, they can raise their representation against the same by using the Representation window provided in the bid details field in Seller dashboard after logging in as a seller within 4 days of bid publication on GeM. Buyer is duty bound to reply to all such representations and would not be allowed to open bids if he fails to reply to such representations.

This Bid is governed by the [General Terms and Conditions/सामान्य नियम और शर्तें](#), conditions stipulated in Bid and [Service Level Agreement](#) specific to this Service as provided in the Marketplace.
