IV. Bidders may submit EMD through instruments like DD, Bankers` Cheque or BG. Bidder has to furnish the same in a sealed envelope separately offline along with other documents mentioned in the tender documents by the stipulated bid submission closing date and time at the address given below in accordance with the provisions set forth in the bidding documents, failing which, online bid shall be treated as non-responsive and shall not be opened.

V. Qualifying Requirements for Bidders: NOT APPLICABLE

However, each bidder will be assessed for meeting following eligibility conditions:

- 1. Agency should have valid NABL certificate and same to be submitted with the offer.
- 2. Agency should have experience of successfully conducting tests mentioned in the tender viz. Ferrography analysis, Elemental Oi analysis / Physiochemical oil analysis of Oil Viscosity @ 40 deg C and 100 deg C / Moisture content by KF / PQ / Total Acid Number (TAN) of Hydraulic Oils (supporting PO / invoice to be enclosed with the offer)
- VA. Any Certificate(s) / Financial Statement(s) / Audited Balance Sheet and P&L Account (wherever applicable) undertaken/ signed by a Member of Institute of Chartered Accountant of India (ICAI), which Bidders submit in support of compliance to Qualifying Requirements (QR), will carry Unique Document Identification Number (UDIN) generated in line with the Gazette Notification of Council of Institute of Chartered Accountant of India (ICAI).
- VI. NTPC reserves the right to reject any or all bids or cancel/withdraw the NIT for the subject package without assigning any reason whatsoever and in such case no bidder/intending bidder shall have any claim arising out of such action.
- **VII.** The bidding document is available online. A complete set of Bidding Documents may be downloaded by any interested Bidder from the NTPC tender website https://gem.gov.in.
- **VIII.** Issuance of bid documents to any bidder shall not construe that such bidder is considered to be qualified.
- **IX.** Transfer of Bidding Documents purchased by one intending Bidder to another is not permissible.
- X. 'Class-I local suppliers' only are eligible to participate in this tender, as defined in the bidding documents/ Public Procurement (Preference to Make in India), Order 2017 and its subsequent amendments/ revisions issued by DPIIT. The bidders may apprise themselves of the relevant provisions of bidding documents in this regard before submission of their bids. It shall be construed that Bidders submitting the bids under the subject NIT are Class-I Local Suppliers.
- XI. Any 'Bidder from a country which shares a land border with India', as specified in the Bidding Documents, will be eligible to bid in this tender only if bidder is registered with the Competent Authority as mentioned in the Bidding Documents.

Further, any bidder (including bidder from India) having specified Transfer of Technology (ToT) arrangement with an entity from a country which shares a land border with India, will be eligible to bid only if the bidder is registered with the same competent authority.

However, the said requirement of registration will not apply to bidders from those countries (even if sharing a land border with India) to which the Government of India has extended lines of credit or in which the Government of India is engaged in development projects.
