The bidder should be a Manufacturer I Supplier of Turbine Condenser for Power Plants and should have Suplied at least one (01) number Main Turbine Condenser for Unit Capacity of minimum 100 MW, which should have been in operation for at least one (1) year, prior to the date of techno-commercial bid opening.

1.2 Route 2

Notes for Clause 1.0 above (Technical Criteria):

- 1. The word "Executed" mentioned above means that the bidder should have achieved the criteria specified above, even if the total contract is started earlier and/or is not completed/closed.
- 2. In case of orders under execution, the value of work executed prior to the date of Techno-Commercial bid opening duly certified by bidder's cli ent shall be considered acceptable.
- 3. For arriving at the executed value of work specified above, basic amou nt only shall be considered. In case contract is inclusive of taxes, bidder should provide the break up of basic value and taxes.

2.0 Financial Criteria:

- 2.1 The Average Annual Turnover of the Bidder, should not be less than **Rs. 98**2 Lakhs (Rupees Nine Crore & Eighty Two Lakhs only) during the preceding three (3) completed financial years as on the date of Techno-Commercial bid opening.
- 2.2 In case the bidder does not satisfy the financial criteria, stipulated at Cl. 2.1 above on its own, its Holding Company would be required to meet the stipulate d turnover requirements at Cl. 2.1 above, provided that the net worth of such H olding Company as on the last day of the preceding financial year is at least eq ual to or more than the paid-up share capital of the Holding Company.
