The bidder who wishes to participate in the bidding shall meet the Qualifying Requirements stipulated hereunder:

1.1 TECHNICAL CRITERIA

1.01 Route-1 [Meeting Criterion 1.01 (a), 1.01(b) & 1.01(c)]

1.01 (a) Proven Experience

The Bidder should be the 'Original Equipment Manufacturer (OEM) of Siemens make Gas Turbine or its equivalent design' **OR** 'manufacturer of Siemens make Gas Turbine **Blades** or its equivalent design'.

Further, the Bidder must have supplied at-least two (2) Sets of **Blades/ Vanes (Out of two sets minimum one set should be Blades)** for Siemens make Gas Turbine or its equivalent design of minimum 100 MW ISO rating, which should have completed successful operation of at least "one Hot Gas Path Inspection (HGPI) or major overhaul" having minimum 15,000 Equivalent Overhauling Hours (EOH) prior to the commercial bid opening date.

1.01 (b) Specific Plant related Technology and capability

Bidder must either himself possess or have access to the necessary technology for manufacturing of **Blades** of Siemens make Gas Turbine Model No. V 94.2 or its equivalent design applicable for Dadri Gas Power Station having ISO rating of **142.42** MW at Turbine Inlet Temp (TIT) of **1060** Deg C.

The Bidder at his option can also outsource any of the activities required for manufacturing of above **Blades** subject to the condition that the chosen outsource agency by the bidder also has the necessary technology for manufacturing of **Blades** of Siemens make Gas Turbine Model No. V 94.2 or its equivalent design applicable for **Dadri** Gas Power Station having ISO rating of **142.42** MW at Turbine Inlet Temp (TIT) of **1060** Degree C.

1.01(c) The Bidder should have executed order for 'Supply of Gas Turbine and/or Gas Turbine Components' within preceding seven (07) years prior to the date of Techno-Commercial bid opening, in any of the following manner

a. **One (1) order having executed value not less than Rs. 1139 Lakh**

1.02 Route-2 [Meeting Criterion 1.02 (a) & 1.02 (b)]

1.02(a) The Bidder can be licensee or Authorized Agent of Gas Turbine original equipment manufacturer (OEM) or its equivalent design. In such case, the bidder can be considered qualified based on the experience of the Principal who meets the requirements mentioned at para 1.01(a) **and** 1.01(b) above.

1.02(b) The “Bidder or its Principal” should have executed order for ‘Supply of Gas Turbine and/or Gas Turbine Components’ within preceding seven (07) years prior to the date of Techno-Commercial bid opening, in any of the following manner

a. One (1) order having executed value not less than **Rs. 1139 Lakh**

OR

b. Two (2) orders having executed value not less than **Rs. 712 Lakh each**

Notes for 1.01 & 1.02:

1. The word “Executed” mentioned above means that the bidder should have achieved the criteria specified above, even if the total contract is started earlier and/or is not completed/closed.

2. In case of orders under execution, the value of work executed prior to the date of Techno- Commercial bid opening duly certified by bidder’s client shall be considered acceptable.

3. For arriving at the executed value of work specified above, basic amount only shall be considered. In case contract is inclusive of taxes, bidder should provide the break – up of basic value and taxes.

- 1.2.2 In case the bidder does not satisfy the financial criteria, stipulated at Cl. 1.2.1 above on its own, its Holding Company would be required to meet the stipulated turnover requirements at Cl. 1.2.1 above, provided that the net worth of such Holding Company as on the last day of the preceding financial year is at least equal to or more than the paid-up share capital of the Holding Company. 1.2.4 In cases where audited results for the last preceding financial year as on the date of Techno- Commercial bid opening are not available, the financial results certified by a practicing Chartered Accountant shall be considered acceptable. In case, Bidder is not able to submit the Certificate from practicing Chartered Accountant certifying its financial parameters, the audited results of three consecutive financial years preceding the last financial year shall be considered for evaluating the financial parameters. Further, a Certificate would be required from the CEO/CFO as per the format enclosed in the bidding documents stating that the financial results of the Company are under audit as on the date of Techno-Commercial bid opening and the Certificate from the practicing Chartered Accountant certifying the financial parameters is not available.
