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# DETAILED NOTICE INVITING EXPRESSION OF INTEREST (EoI)

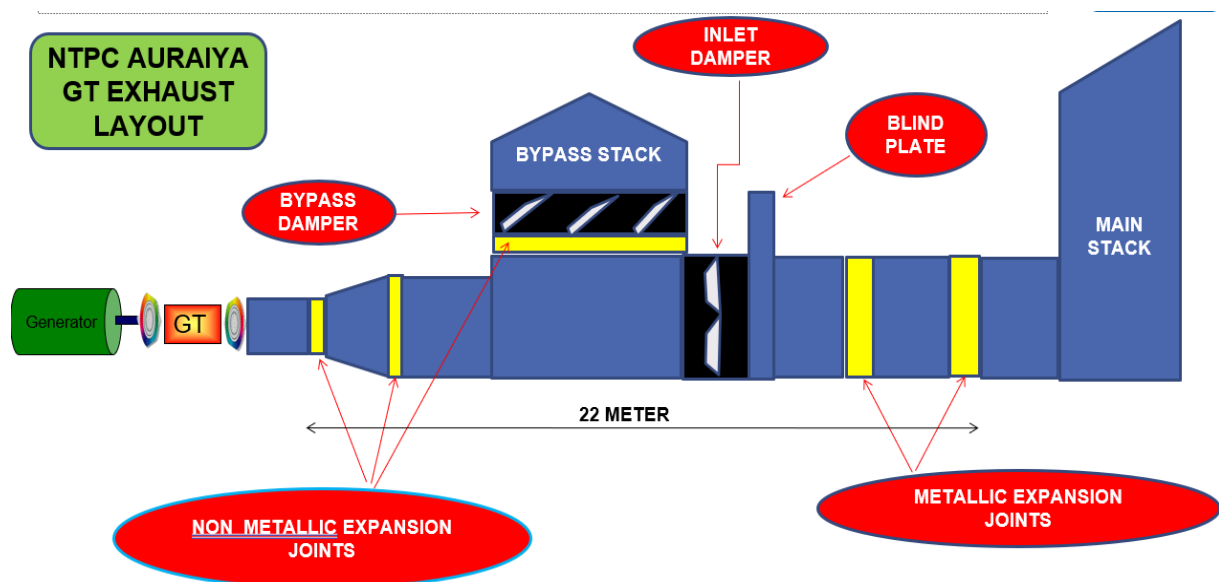

1. Auraiya Gas Power Station, an unit of NTPC Limited is Inviting Expression of Interest from Companies/ vendors for a work of Major Repair/Replacement of Multi louver dampers & associated Exhaust ducting, Expansion joints and Blind plate along with insulation of Gas Turbine Exhaust Systems.

NTPC Auraiya unit is operating 4 nos. Gas Turbines (GT) and 2 nos. Steam Turbines of MHI, Japan make model MHI/MW 701D. These were commissioned in the year 1989 and have been in commercial operation since 1990. Subsequently Renovation of GTs were carried out.

The capacity of each Gas turbine is of 111.19 MW with an exhaust temperature of approx. 550 deg C, pressure 400 mmwc and flow of 1489000 kg/hr.



Pictorial representation of existing GT exhaust duct system

The exhaust system from Gas turbine outlet to Waste Heat Recovery Boiler (WHRB) system at Auraiya is around 22 meter in length as shown above. This includes exhaust diffuser, transition ducts, 3 nos. Non. Metallic and two nos. metallic expansion joints, Multi Louvre type Bypass & Inlet dampers, Guillotine dampers/blind plate, its actuation mechanisms, support system etc. The complete set as mentioned shall be referred as the exhaust system henceforth. This exhaust system directs hot flue gas from the outlet of gas turbine to the bypass stack or to the WHRB as per open cycle or combined cycle requirement.

Since this handle high temperature flue gas at high velocity, the parent duct which is made of alloy steel (ASTM A387 Gr.12) is internally insulated and lined with SS-409 plates. Besides this, the total duct is also externally insulated with aluminum cladding to minimize heat loss.

To enable the open cycle and combined cycle operation, the station is provided with multi louvre bypass and inlet dampers which operates in tandem to direct flue gas either to bypass stack or to WHRB. All these components are part of system supplied by EPC Contractor M/s MHI, Japan.

Due to the ageing, repeated issues of leakages from duct and passing in both multi louvre dampers are being encountered. To ensure smooth and safe operation, NTPC Auraiya intends to get repaired both the Multi louver dampers & associated ducting, Expansion joints and Blind plate along with insulation to facilitate proper sealing and minimizing heat losses.

**Introduction & Intent of EOI**

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## **1. INTRODUCTION**

- a) NTPC Limited generates more than 300 billion units of electricity per year through its power plant assets of coal, gas, hydel and renewable energy-based totaling approximately 75 GW capacity spread across the country. Furthermore, NTPC intends to reach a capacity of 130 GW by 2032.
- b) Auraiya Gas Power Station, is one of the Units of NTPC Ltd. Generating Electricity from Natural gas/ liquid fuel based Industrial Gas Turbines in Open or Combined Cycle mode.
- c) **Geographical details of Auraiya Gas Power Station:-** NTPC Auraiya is located at Dibiypur in Auraiya district in the Indian state of Uttar Pradesh. Plant is well connected by Railway thru Paphund Station on Delhi Howrah route located somewhat midway between Etawah and Kanpur Stations. Paphund Railway station is approx. 2.5 kms away from plant, with Etawah being approximately 45 Kms and Kanpur Station being at approx. 85 Kms. It can be accessed by Road as well both from Etawah and Kanpur with Etawah being approximately 65 Kms and Kanpur Station being at approx. 120 Kms. Nearest Airport is Kanpur, approx. 130 Kms by road and Lucknow at approx. 175 Kms.

## **2. INTENT OF THE EXPRESSION OF INTEREST (EoI)**

- a) NTPC Auraiya intends to get repaired/ replaced **complete Exhaust system** as explained earlier consisting of both the Multi louver dampers & associated ducting, Expansion joints and Blind plate along with insulation to facilitate proper sealing and minimizing heat losses, in all its four (4) Gas Turbines.
  - b) Interested Applicants, at their own expenses, can visit Auraiya Site for assessing the actual site conditions and understand actual requirement in consultation with site representatives.
  - c) Necessary logistics and support may be provided by Site to facilitate the same.
  - d) Necessary Technical details, as available (without violating OEMs Proprietary Rights) with Site, may be shared/ provided by Site to facilitate the same.
  - e) Based on their actual assessment of Gas Turbine Exhaust System at Auraiya Site, Applicants/Bidders may furnish its Comprehensive Technical Proposal/s. Proposal/s shall be per Unit. The Comprehensive Proposal/s shall necessarily include the followings: -
    - i) Brief concept of the job.
    - ii) Brief Procedure for the Work.
    - iii) Complete Bill of Material required for the job per Unit.
    - iv) Special T&Ps required for execution of the proposed job,
    - v) Special Safety measures to be taken during execution of the work
    - vi) Estimated cost per Unit.
    - vii) Timeline (in the form of a Bar Chart)
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- f) The interested applicants will specify the details mentioned in Section-V of this document.
- g) The qualification and selection criteria of the bidders is mentioned in Section-IV of this document.
- h) The Bidder shall for each criterion i.e., Compulsory and technical, upload a separate single scanned file containing all the relevant documents duly signed and stamped on each page by the authorized signatory as mentioned in Section IV of this document.

i) **Compulsory criteria**

The responses submitted by Applicants shall be scrutinized to establish interest in for repair of both the Multi louver dampers & associated ducting, Expansion joints and Blind plate along with insulation to facilitate proper sealing and minimizing heat losses. Responses shall be deemed non-responsive for the following reasons:

- a) Responses that are incomplete, i.e., not accompanied by any of the applicable formats inter alia covering letter, power of attorney, applicable undertakings, provided in more details at annexure in Section-V.
- b) Responses not signed by authorized signatory and/or stamped in the manner indicated in this EoI;
- c) Material inconsistencies in the information/ documents submitted by the applicant
- d) An Applicant submitting more than one response to this EoI either itself or through an affiliate or subsidiary company.
- e) Response validity being less than that required as per Clause 5 of section-III of this EoI.
- f) Response being conditional in nature.
- g) Response not received by the response Deadline.
- h) Response having Conflict of Interest.
- i) Applicant delaying in the submission of additional information or clarifications sought by NTPC, as applicable.
- j) Responses which do not fulfill the Compulsory Criteria.

## **2. EVALUATION METHODOLOGY**

The Bidder/Applicant would be evaluated on a single stage basis, where the bidder must fulfill the compulsory criteria and then evaluation of technical criteria will be done and the evaluation will be decided as below: -

- a) The details mentioned in compulsory criteria shall have to be met by the bidder for further evaluation of technical criteria.
- b) The technical criteria will have the details regarding the bidder's organization, consortium memberships, legal criteria's, net worth and average turnover for the previous 3 years.
- c) Each bidder will submit a single compulsory, technical criteria bid.

### **COMPULSORY CRITERIA: -**

The following criteria will qualify the bidder regarding the bidder's organization, legal, safety, environmental and quality assurance, which are considered as the basic compulsory qualifications required by the bidder. The bidder who 'Pass' in all the compulsory qualification criteria's will only be considered eligible for the technical evaluation.
