2. Terms and Conditions stipulated in ATC will supersede those in GEM GTC in case of any conflicting provisions.
3. It shall be deemed that bid submitted by the bidder is unconditionally accepted with all the clauses mentioned in BID (including attachment-9, & 13 & appendix of ATC) which is in line with GeM seller undertaking Sl. 3.0 "I have read all the Bid conditions including the GeM GTC, STC and also all the clauses incorporated by the Buyer in ATC and various corrigendum of the bid. 6. Bidders are advised to mention their prices at the designated place only on the GeM portal as the same shall only be considered for evaluation and price content mentioned / uploaded along with any other documents in their bid shall not be considered in any case.
7. **Matching of IP addresses** : Recently, IP address functionality introduced in GeM portal. The primary objective of this new feature is to identify collusion activities between sellers by capturing their IP addresses. During the technical evaluation stage, **in case of common IP address of a seller with any other seller as popped up in a tender by GeM portal, all such bids shall be liable for rejection.**
8. The format of the Bank Guarantee shall be in accordance with the form of Bank Guarantee towards Bid Security/EMD/Performance security included in the Employer's Bidding Documents only.
