



1. Introduction

NGEL is an umbrella company for the green business initiatives of NTPC and undertakes projects through organic and inorganic routes and aims to be the flag-bearer of NTPC's green energy journey to achieve the ambitious target of 60 GW by FY 32. The installed RE capacity of 8 GW, an additional 24 GW is in pipeline.

The company has strategically diversified its portfolio within the realm of Green Energies and participating in bidding process, tenders, and Ultra Mega Renewable Energy Power Parks (UMREPP), to achieve growth over the decade and act as a premier "Green Energy" player in India as well as globally.

NGEL is developing the largest Green Hydrogen Hub in Pudimadaka, near Visakhapatnam, Andhra Pradesh. It was declared as India's first National Green Hydrogen Hub by the Hon'ble Prime Minister of India on 8th Jan' 2025 while laying the foundation stone for the project at Visakhapatnam.

The Hub is slated to produce **2.5 MMTPA Green Chemicals** (Ammonia, Methanol, e-SAF, Green Urea etc.). The Hub would have Electrolyser of 7 GW capacity, 7.5 GW GIS substations, 7.5 GW transmission lines from CTU substation, Captive Port/Jetty, Desalination Plant, Chemical storage, logistics area, utilities area, common buildings etc.

The green power for the energy intensive hub shall be arranged by NGEL from Andhra Pradesh.


To be considered for setting up project(s) in the Hub, the proposed projects must meet the below mentioned criteria:

• RE power and water AND/OR Green Hydrogen AND/OR Biogenic CO2 AND/OR Green Ammonia to be sourced from NGEL only.

3. Purpose of the Expression of Interest (EOI)

The primary objectives of this EOI are to:

- Support NGEL's vision to develop India's largest Green Hydrogen Hub by 2032.
- Develop capacities for export and also for early development of the complete ecosystem.
- To contribute to the economy of the state and generate employment.
- To contribute towards the National Green Hydrogen Mission of the country and make India an energy secure nation aiming to become a net exporter of energy.


