The work "Deployment of various machinery for maintenance of ash dyke including monsoon period at Dhanras Ash Dyke, NTPC Korba for 12 Months (2026-27)" is includes deployment of machineries- Poclain, Triple axle tipper, Backhoe Loader, Motor Grader, Vibratory roller, chain mounted dozer etc as per direction of EIC, mainly for attending various important works in the entire ash dyke area. 3.2.2	In case the Bidder does not satisfy the financial criteria, stipulated at Cl. No. 3.2.1 above on its own, its Holding Company would be required to meet the stipulated turnover requirements at Cl. No. 3.2.1 above, provided that the Net Worth of such Holding Company as on the last day of the preceding financial year is at least equal to or more than the paid-up share capital of the Holding Company. In such an event, the Bidder would be required to furnish along with its Techno- Commercial bid, a Letter of Undertaking from the Holding Company, supported by the Holding Company's Board Resolution, as per the format enclosed in the Bid Documents, pledging unconditional & irrevocable financial support for the execution of the contract by the bidder in case of award.
