Part 1: General Information

General Details about NTPC Ramagundam and Telangana:

NTPC Ramagundam and Telangana, located at Peddapalli district, Telangana -505215 having a total installed capacity of 2600 MW at NTPC Ramagundam and 1600 MW at NTPC Telangana, is engaged in the business of generation and sale of bulk power.

To utilize the fly ash in gainful and sustainable manner as per the provisions of extant MOEF&CC Gazette Notification, revised guidelines of MoP dt:30.01.2026 and to promote utilization of fly ash among MSEs (Micro and Small Enterprises) and local users (located within 100 Km radius of NTPC Ramagundam) engaged in ash based product manufacturing, NTPC Ramagundam and Telangana intends to issue Fly Ash on prorated basis, with transportation cost being borne by the user Agencies.

To facilitate this, NTPC Ramagundam and Telangana invites Expressions of Interest for above, for a period of 01 (One) year, from its 2600 MW plant at NTPC Ramagundam and 1600 MW plant at NTPC Telangana. Further details regarding this Expression of Interest (Eoi) are as follows:

EXPRESSION OF INTEREST:

NTPC Ramagundam and Telangana invites Expression of Interest (EOI) for above, from interested Agencies, for utilization of Fly ash in ash-based product manufacturing as per extant MOEF&CC Notification, in the prescribed **formats (Part-2 & Part-3)**.

How to apply:

Interested MSEs, Local MSEs/Local Users desirous of receiving fly ash from NTPC Ramagundam and Telangana as per the terms and conditions of this Eoi, may submit their Expression of Interest along with specified documents and duly filled-in enclosed **“Part 2: Format for Submission of Response to EOI”** and **“Part 3: Undertaking and Declaration by Agency”** to the E – Mail address **audrnt@ntpc.co.in** on or before 18:00 hrs. of 7th May 2026.

Documents to be submitted with duly filled “Part 2 - Format for Submission of Response to EOI” and “Part 3: Undertaking and Declaration by Agency”:

- PAN, GST

- Valid MSE certificate /Udyam Aadhar Certificate
- 'Consent to Operate' Certificate from CPCB/SPCB as applicable
- Registration certificate of Industry issued by District Industry Centre or Certificate issued by Gram Panchayat Secretary of concerned Govt. as applicable
- Industrial Electricity connection bill

All documents submitted shall be duly self-certified by the participant as being true and authentic. Interest / Offer / Bid is liable to be rejected if documentation is not complete.

Allocation of Fly Ash Quantity:

Based on the evaluation of responses to EoI received with in the stipulated date and time, Fly Ash shall be allocated to eligible agencies on pro-rata basis with transportation cost to be borne by the User agencies. However, collecting from NTPC`s issue location and transportation, thereafter, will be in the scope of the Agency only. `

In case the same Agency gets some allocation against both the Auction Process and this EoI, then the Ash quantity allocated against this EoI shall be issued to that Agency, only after the Agency completes the lifting of the allocation against the Auction on monthly prorata basis.

Daily allocation of Fly Ash shall be done as given below:

1. *All successful Agencies shall submit a monthly requisition containing a list of their day-wise requested quantities for each month.*
2. *Lifting Sequence & allocation shall be finalized by NTPC depending upon site specific conditions.*
3. *All allocated Agencies shall be expected to follow the above schedule and mobilize accordingly.*
4. *In case of non-mobilization / inadequate mobilization, NTPC may, at its discretion, allocate such quantity to alternate Agency(s) / avenue(s). Decision of Engineer in Charge (EIC)- NTPC shall be final and binding in this regard.*

Fly Ash shall be issued from the discharge chute of designated ash Silo, Other Suitable Locations as decided by the Engineer in charge (EIC) of the respective NTPC Station, on 'as is where is' basis.

Refundable Security Deposit (SD):

Successful Agency shall be required to submit Refundable Security Deposit amount along with submission of LOA / LOI acceptance after Evaluation of submitted requests and Ash Allocation Process, at the rate of Rs. 1.00 / MT subject to minimum of Rs. 10,000. This SD will be kept for ensuring commitment of the Successful Agency(s) for lifting the allocated Ash. An amount at the rate of Rs. 1.00 / MT of un-lifted quantity will be forfeited.

This Security Deposit will be refundable after adjustment of amount to be recovered, if any. This adjusted SD amount will be refunded within 30 days of end of the contract period or lifting of entire allocated quantity, whichever is earlier.

In case of fly ash quantity allocated to me / us:

I / We agree to abide by the directions of the EIC (Engineer in Charge) with regard to procedures for collection of the Ash including Plant entry and exit, Weighment, Sequence of Loading, Discipline to be maintained while inside the Plant, Mobilization of adequate number of bulkers / covered trucks / suitable transportation arrangement conducive to environment friendly handling and transport etc. I / We agree to carry out the above as per instructions of, and to the full satisfaction of the EIC.

I / We agree to comply with all applicable statutory regulations including those regarding safety, environment, sustainability, road / rail transport etc. I / We shall fulfill all applicable statutory requirements for, and in connection with the execution of the contract.

I / We agree to cooperate with the EIC and with the other agencies working in the area as directed by EIC with the objective of smooth and safe execution of the collection / lifting and utilization of Fly Ash.

I / We agree to submit indemnity bond indemnifying NTPC Ltd and its JVs / Subsidiaries from any liability, whatsoever, which may arise due to violation / Non – compliance of any applicable norms / rules / regulations/ Guidelines / laws during the course of execution and for future obligations (if any) by way of omission or commission by me / us or my / our representatives / agents.

I / We hereby undertake to utilize the ash issued by TPP for only Ash Utilization Avenues as identified in extant MOEF & CC Notification. I/We also agree to submit on Half Yearly basis, an affidavit, on “Actual Utilization” of the issued ash for the purposes/ Avenues as identified in extant MOEF & CC Notification.

I / We shall have no objection to the forfeiture of security deposit amount, in case I / we fail to execute the contract faithfully and the contract is terminated as per contract conditions mentioned in LOA /LOI.

I / We hereby also declare that all the particulars furnished by us in this EoI are true and

authentic to the best of my/our knowledge and I / we understand and accept that if at any stage, the information furnished is found to be incorrect or false, I am / we are liable for disqualification from this EoI and also liable for any other penal action that may arise due to the above.

DECLARATION

I / We understand that:

1. This EoI by NTPC is not a commitment for Fly Ash tie-up/ agreement.
2. I / We shall be bearing all costs associated with the preparation and submission of the EoI. NTPC will, in no case be responsible or liable for these costs, regardless of the conduct or outcome of the assessment / evaluation process.
3. Not Applicable.
4. Allocation will be done pro rata basis, to the parties who have submitted all requisite documents, complete in all respect within the stipulated time of submission of interest. Receipt of request will be treated as received on receipt of all specified documents only.
5. Refundable Security Deposit: I / We shall be required to submit Refundable Security Deposit amount at the rate of Re 1.00 / MT subject to minimum of Rs. 10,000, along with submission of LOA / LOI acceptance. This Security Deposit will be refundable as per the conditions of LOA / LOI. In case of non-receipt of LOA / LOI acceptance along with requisite security deposit and other specified documents required by the respective station within stipulated time, TPP reserves the right to cancel the Fly Ash allocation to me / us.

Part 4: Terms and Conditions and General Guidelines:

ALLOCATION OF FLY ASH AGAINST EXPRESSION OF INTEREST (EOI) to MSEs, LOCAL MSEs/ LOCAL Users

NTPC Ramagundam and Telangana STPP intend to sell **7.0 LMT (3.0 LMT from NTPC Ramagundam and 4.0 LMT from NTPC Telangana)** at **INR10/- per MT** of fly ash through Expression of interest (EOI) to MSEs , Local MSEs/Users and would make available allocated quantity of Fly Ash from designated Storage Area at NTPC Ramagundam and Telangana as decided by Engineer-In-Charge subject to Force Majeure conditions and unplanned outage of Plant etc., on “As on Availability” basis. NTPC reserves the right to supply the quantity not lifted by the qualified agencies to any other party at the sole discretion of NTPC.

Basis of evaluation of responses received against EOI.

Responses received against the EOI will be evaluated by a committee based on predefined criteria including submission of following valid applicable documents:

- 1.1. PAN, GST
- 1.2. Valid MSE (Micro and Small Enterprises) certificate /Udyam Aadhar Certificate
- 1.3. ‘Consent to Operate’ Certificate from CPCB/SPCB as applicable
- 1.4. Registration certificate of Industry issued by District Industry Centre or concerned State Govt. Authority as applicable
- 1.5. Industrial Electricity connection bill of the manufacturing facility

Terms and Conditions of Fly Ash Supply:

The order of allotment issued to qualified agencies shall be performed strictly in accordance with the terms and conditions as follows.

1. Allocation Period:

The allocation period shall be effective from the date of issue of allotment order or as per the instructions of NTPC’s Engineer-In-Charge. The completion date of allocation period is **Twelve (12) months from the date of start**, or till the completion of supply of allocated quantity, whichever is earlier.

2. Price:

Fly ash will be issued at INR 10/- per MT provided the qualified agency is willing to bear the transportation cost.

3. Security Deposit (SD):

Security deposit @ INR 1/- per MT of allocated fly ash subject to a minimum of **INR 10,000/-** will be deposited online by the qualified agency before start of lifting ash. The SD will be returned after successful completion of the lifting of allocated

quantity. In case of non-lifting/ partial lifting, an amount@Rs.1/- per MT of Non- Lifted quantity will be forfeited.

4. Working Hours:

Fly Ash is intended to be issued on all days (on 24 x 7 basis), including national holidays or as per Engineer-in-Charge.

5. Quality of Fly Ash:

Fly Ash shall be issued from designated delivery point in NTPC Ramagundam and Telangana STPP, on "As Available Basis".

6. Delivery point:

NTPC Ramagundam and Telangana would issue Fly Ash from designated Fly Ash storage area at NTPC Ramagundam and Telangana or as decided by Engineer-In-Charge. Fly Ash shall be considered to have been issued and collected as it passes into the qualified agency's vehicle at the loading point.

7. Commencement of first off take:

Commencement of first off take of Fly Ash by the agency should not exceed beyond ten **(10) days** from the date of issue of this allotment letter **after deposit of Security deposit for the total allocated quantity** unless specifically agreed by NTPC. The **allotment order may be cancelled in case of delay in offtake for more than ten (10) days** as per the discretion of NTPC without giving any notice to the qualified agency.

8. Weighment:

- a. Fly Ash shall be issued based on actual weighment/ carrying capacity of the Trucks/Bulkers as decided by Engineer-In-Charge (EIC) subject to availability of weigh bridge.
- b. Unit: The lifted Fly Ash shall be weighed in the terms of MT (Metric Ton).
- c. Weighment: Weighment of lifted Fly Ash shall be done at the authorized weighment facility of NTPC / calibrated weighbridge facility of the Agency. Weights recorded shall be considered final. (in case NTPC weighbridge is not available due to maintenance/breakdown carrying capacity of the Trucks/Bulkers will be considered for the fly ash delivered).

9. Delivery:

- a. The qualified agency should depute his authorized representative to the power station for co-ordination and taking delivery of Fly Ash.
- b. The owner has the right to suspend the delivery of Fly Ash if proper instruction of EIC as per the site requirement is not followed from time to time and such suspension of delivery shall be to the account of qualified agency.

10. Accounting of Fly Ash quantity:

- a. Challan in duplicate copy with predefined serial number will be jointly signed & issued to each vehicle at the exit of the plant. The challan book as per the required format of NTPC has to be arranged by the lifting agency.
- b. All the challan copy will be duly signed & stamped by the Agency/NTPC representative at loading point. The original copy of challan will be kept with NTPC & the duplicate

- copy will be handed over to the agency representative.
- c. The quantity lifted from Ash Plant will be counted as the issued quantity.

11. Lifting Sequence and Allocation:

- a. To be finalized by Engineer-In-Charge depending upon site specific conditions.
- b. In case of non-mobilization / inadequate mobilization, NTPC may at its discretion, allocate such quantity to alternate users(s) / avenue(s). Decision of Engineer-In-Charge, NTPC shall be final and binding in this regard.
- c. In case the same Agency gets some allocation against both the Auction Process and this EoI, then the Ash quantity allocated against this EoI shall be issued to that Agency, only after the Agency completes the lifting / drawl of the allocation against the Auction Process on monthly prorata basis.**

12. Upward Quantity Flexibility:

No upward variation in quantity would be allowed.

13. Cancellation of Allocation Order:

- a. After commencement of first off take, qualified agency will be required to lift Fly Ash on regular basis. **The qualified agency shall have to lift 90% of the monthly prorata quantity.** The monthly quantity shall be considered from the scheduled date of start till completion of month and subsequently so on till expiry of total allocation.
- b. **In case, Fly Ash offtake falls below 90% of (the contracted or adjusted quantity, whichever is lower), during any month, NTPC reserves the right to cancel the allocation order without giving any notice** in writing of their intentions to do so and in such an event the qualified agency shall not be entitled to any compensation from the owner.
- c. **In the event of cancellation of allocation order, the SD amount @Rs.1/- per MT for the non- lifted quantity of the agency will be forfeited** without giving any notice to the qualified agency, provided shortfall is because of the reasons attributable to Qualified agency.
- d. NTPC also reserves the right to terminate the order at any time in the event of breach of allotment order by the agency without any notice in writing of their intentions to do so and in such an event the qualified agency shall not be entitled to any compensation from the owner.
- e. Following will constitute **breach of allotment order:**
- v) Delay in first offtake by qualified agency from a committed date of more than ten days.
 - v) The qualified agency is not complying with operational and safety requirements and neglecting the instructions of Engineer-In-Charge.
 - v) The qualified agency has failed to discharge its obligations according to the terms and conditions of the order.
 - v) The order for issue of Fly Ash may be terminated at any time depending on the policy of the Government and / or other concerned authorities.
 - v) NTPC reserves the right to withdraw the allocation in the interest and safety of the power station at any time without any notice in writing to the qualified agency.

14. Shortfall in supply by Owner:

- a. Fly Ash is a product of coal combustion, which again is subject to the demand of electricity in the areas allocated by the regulatory authorities. Scheduled and unscheduled shutdowns also affect generation of electricity and thus generation of Fly Ash. Though all efforts will be made to maintain contracted quantity of Fly Ash available, NTPC does not guarantee availability of Fly Ash as per allocated quantity regularly and will not be liable for any compensation or damages for non-issue of required quantity of the Fly Ash.
- b. In case the owner is unable to provide the average monthly prorated quantity of Fly Ash due to any reasons including forced outages of the plant, congestions etc. NTPC, in respect of agency shall accordingly adjust the average monthly prorated quantity downward.
- c. Determination of monthly prorated quantity for cancellation of allocation in case of short supply by NTPC shall also be computed w.r.t quantity made available to the qualified agency on monthly basis.

16. Affidavit for Utilization of Ash:

Qualified agency shall submit affidavit on Non – judicial stamp paper of requisite value before commencement of first offtake, certifying the complete use of issued NTPC Fly Ash certifying the adherence to provisions identified vide extant MoEF&CC Notification and other applicable statutory regulations.

17. Authorized Person:

A proper authorization in the format prescribed by Engineer-In-Charge must be presented to Engineer-in-Charge if the qualified agency wants to depute an agent/transporter on its behalf.

18. Safety:

The qualified agency would be responsible for the safety of its people for which the qualified agency should provide necessary safety gear to its workers. All ash transporting vehicles should be in good condition having all valid documents and each vehicle shall be equipped with horn, reverse horn, lights, revers lights, side indicators etc. Safety guidelines would be followed by the Qualified agency as per instruction of Engineer-In-Charge.

The qualified agency shall be fully responsible for maintaining all the insurance covers as per the law of land at its own cost.

19. Pollution Control and Transportation of Fly Ash:

All possible measures would be taken by the qualified agency to avoid pollution to the satisfaction of the plant officials. Similarly, while transporting, no spillage of Fly Ash would be permitted to avoid air pollution. If the process adopted by the qualified agency is found to be deficient, NTPC retains the right to stop the Fly Ash supply forthwith.

20. Transportation including Bagging / Packing of Fly Ash and any other related activity is in the scope of the agency. No claim whatsoever, by the agency for transportation of Fly Ash will be payable.

21. The qualified agency and its transporter would be entirely responsible towards MVI/RTO for overloading Fly Ash. NTPC in any case will not be held responsible for the same.
22. Indemnities for Environmental Conditions: All Regulatory and Statutory compliances to be sued by the agency while lifting/transportation/Disposal/Usage/Sale etc.
23. The qualified agency will submit an **Indemnity bond** as per the prescribed format (Annexure –03) to keep NTPC indemnified against legal proceedings / paying damages arising out of non-compliances by the agency, if any.
24. **Compliance by Agency:**
Agencies to comply with all reasonable controls imposed by NTPC and to cooperate with the station and other operating agencies / contractors and to abide by the decision of Engineer-In-Charge
25. **Dispute Resolution:**
Disputes, if any, shall be resolved through mutual consultation. The decision of Engineer-In-Charge, NTPC shall be final and binding in this regard. However, in case of escalation of dispute, the extant procedures in NTPC, i.e., Conciliation, Expert Settlement Council, Arbitration, etc. will be available. Only Telangana High Court shall have exclusive jurisdiction in all matters of disputes pertaining to the EOI for supply of Fly Ash.
