NTPC Khargone (2x660MW) invites Expression of Interest (Eoi) in the prescribed format for receiving Pond Ash through Environment Friendly manner from station Ash Dyke for the agencies engaged in construction activities such as road laying, road and flyover embankments, shoreline protection structures in coastal districts and dams, Mine Owners for Mine backfilling and OB Mixing, within 300 kms radius from NTPC Khargone. Station shall supply the ash 'on free of cost' and 'as is where is' basis and shall bear the Transportation cost.

Quantity: Expected Pond Ash quantity- **8.17 LMT**, **Duration:** One year, **Location:** Ash Dyke of NTPC Limited Khargone.

Part 1: General Information

General Details about NTPC Khargone:

Both units of NTPC, Khargone have been put into operation after declaration of COD on **01.02.2020 & 04.04.2020**, according to the installed capacity of NTPC, Khargone, Stage-I achieved 1320 MW with effect from 04.04.2020. Accordingly, around **4500-5000 MT** of Ash is being generated on daily basis. The residual Ash after Utilization is being sent to Ash Dyke for Storage. Expected Pond Ash quantity for **EOI** is **8.17 LMT** for next one year from **June'2026 to May'2027**.

To utilize the fly ash in gainful and sustainable manner as per the provisions of extant MOEF&CC Gazette Notification and promote utilization of fly ash as resource material, NTPC KHARGONE intends to issue its Dry Ash on free of cost to Road Projects / Flyover embankments / Dams / Mines / Shoreline Protection structures in coastal Districts (as per extant MoEF&CC Notification and policy). Transportation cost (to the extent requested by the interested Ash User – with the provision that agency requesting the least support shall be given higher preference) shall be borne by NTPC KHARGONE within limits and as per criteria set by extant Government Notification, Advisory and Policy. Preference shall be given to requests having minimum cost implication to NTPC for ash transportation.

To facilitate this, NTPC Khargone invites Expressions of Interest for above, for a period of 01 (One) year, from its **2 X 660 MW** units. Further details regarding this Expression of Interest (Eoi) are as follows: -

NTPC Khargone invites Expression of Interest (EOI) for above, from interested Users, for utilization of pond ash in avenues as identified in extant MOEF & CC Notification, in the prescribed **formats (Part-2 &Part-3)**.

All documents submitted shall be duly self-certified by the participant as being true and authentic. Interest / Offer / Bid is liable to be rejected if documentation is not complete.

Please note: Documents to be submitted by the Ash User(s) during the period of Ash supply:

1. Daily Progress Report as per the specified format by Engineer-in-Charge (EIC) at NTPC KHARGONE.
2. Quantity Received Certificate on Periodic basis as agreed with Engineer-in-Charge (EIC)
3. Affidavit for Actual Ash Utilization as per extant MoEF&CC Gazette Notification on Half Yearly basis in format prescribed by Engineer-in-Charge (EIC).
4. Any other document as required by the Engineer-in-Charge (EIC).
5. User must install **AsTram application** provided by NTPC and implement it at unloading end for the vehicles deployed for Ash transportation and may follow instructions prescribed by Engineer-in-Charge (EIC).

All documents submitted shall be duly self-certified by the participant as being true and authentic. Response / Interest / Offer / Bid is liable to be rejected if documentation is not complete.

Allocation of pond ash Quantity: -

Based on the receipt of responses to this Notice, Pond ash shall be allocated to various Ash Users for qualified projects, keeping in view minimum cost implication to NTPC for transportation of Ash, till the available/ offered quantity is exhausted.

In case the same Ash User gets some allocation against the last Auction Process and / or EoI for free issue with transportation by Ash User and also against this Notice, then the Ash quantity allocated against this Notice shall be issued to that Ash User, only after the Ash User completes the lifting / drawl of the allocation against the Auction Process and / or EoI for free issue with transportation by Ash User as applicable.

Daily allocation of Pond ash shall be finalized by EIC depending upon site specific conditions and availability of Ash at the Station on that particular day. The ash shall be delivered to designated site / location as indicated in the requisition through transporters appointed by NTPC for the purpose. Ash User shall ensure timely unloading of the ash at destination and release of vehicles in reasonable time.

Daily allocation of pond ash shall be done as given below:

1. *All successful users shall submit a monthly requisition containing a list of their day-wise requested quantities for each month by the 22nd of the previous month.*
2. *Based on above, corresponding annual allocated quantity and availability. NTPC shall determine and intimate the day wise allocation for each month by 28th of the previous month.*
3. *All allocated users (or transportation vendors) shall be expected to follow the above schedule and mobilize accordingly.*
4. *In case of non-mobilization / inadequate mobilization, NTPC may, at its discretion, allocate such quantity to alternate user(s) / avenue(s). Decision of Engineer-in-Charge (EIC)-NTPC shall be final and binding in this regard.*

Pond ash shall be issued from the Ash Dyke as decided by EIC of the respective NTPC Station, on 'as is where is' basis.

I / We agree to cooperate with the EIC and the deputed transportation agency / agencies in facilitating timely unloading of Pond ash as per submitted schedule and in timely submission of details of measurement.

I / We hereby also declare that all the particulars furnished by us against this Notice are true and authentic to the best of my/our knowledge and I / we understand and accept that if at any stage, the information furnished is found to be incorrect or false, I am / we are liable for disqualification from this Notice and also liable for any other penal action that may arise due to the above.

3. Allocation of Ash to different Eligible Projects shall be done by TPP in compliance with extant MoEF&CC Notification and in a manner, which will have minimum financial implication on TPP, till the offered quantity gets exhausted.
4. **(Applicable for parties allocated Pond ash through last auction / Eol process also from same Station)**

I / We have been allocated ash through auction process also from same station. I / We understand that if additional quantity of Ash is allocated to me / us on free of cost basis through under this Notice, it shall be mandatory on my / our part to collect all the Ash quantity allocated through last Auction process and / or Eol, then only quantity allocated against this Notice will be issued to me / us for lifting.

Part 4: Terms and Conditions and General Guidelines:

1. Pond Ash shall be issued from the Ash Dyke to the Ash Users (or their authorized representatives, as may be approved in writing by the Engineer-in-Charge (EIC)) based on the availability of excavated ash at the Dyke and subject to operational, safety, and other site-related considerations as determined by the EIC.
2. The Ash User acknowledges and agrees that NTPC shall not be held liable for any delay, shortfall, or non-supply of ash arising from such constraints. The Ash User further undertakes that any delay in project execution, increase in project costs, or any other consequential loss arising out of delayed or non-delivery of ash by NTPC shall be solely at the Ash User's risk and cost, and no claim whatsoever shall lie against NTPC on this account.
3. Statutory / regulatory compliances shall be binding upon all the Ash Users and verifiable by TPP.
4. On allocation of Pond ash against this Notice, Successful Ash Users shall submit affidavit on Non – judicial stamp paper of requisite value, certifying the complete Utilization of issued Pond ash, in adherence with the provisions of the extant Notification and other applicable statutory regulations. This affidavit, in prescribed format, shall be submitted on Half Yearly basis to the EIC.
5. In case of any liability on TPP, in any manner that arises due to non-compliance of any Environmental and Transportation Norms, Rules, Guidelines and Statutory provisions by the Ash User or its representative / agent, during the course of execution and for future obligations (if any) by way of omission or commission, the Ash User shall keep TPP effectively indemnified of any such liability. An indemnity bond shall be submitted before start of lifting of Ash.
6. Interested and eligible Ash Users undertaking the Project shall submit a tentative project implementation schedule along with their Expression of Interest (EOI). The schedule shall include, inter alia, the project execution timeline, key milestones, and the planned chainage-wise monthly ash requirement for the entire project period. The submitted schedule shall form the basis for planning and monitoring of ash allocation and utilization and shall be subject to review by NTPC.
7. All Eligible Projects shall source Ash from Thermal Power Plants (TPPs) closest to their Project. Allocation of Ash by TPP shall be in compliance with the same.
8. It shall also be the responsibility of the Ash User(s) to ensure that the Ash sent from the TPP is facilitated for quick unloading and release of vehicle.
9. NTPC reserves its right to take appropriate action as deemed fit, in case information / details provided are found false even at a later date.

10. The User shall mandatorily install and implement the AsTram application provided by NTPC at the unloading end for all vehicles engaged in ash transportation. The User shall comply with all procedures, operational requirements, and instructions issued by the Engineer-in-Charge (EIC) from time to time. Any failure to implement or operate the AsTram system as prescribed may result in suspension of ash issuance and/or other actions as deemed appropriate by NTPC.
