CIRCULAR NO. 763

Sub.: Publishing of 'Invitation of Bid' / 'Notice Inviting Tenders' (IFB/NIT) – regarding

- 1.0 Based on the policy guidelines issued earlier vide System Circular No. 610 dated 31.05.2007, Abridged IFB/NIT is being published in newspapers and detailed IFB/NIT is being hosted on NTPC website along with Salient Technical Features.
- 2.0 It has now been decided to dis-continue the publication of abridged IFB / NIT in newspapers. Further, in case of tenders invited on International Competitive Bidding Basis, Full text of IFB / NIT (i.e. Detailed IFB / NIT) in Indian Trade Journal shall not be published.
- 3.0 Detailed IFB/ NIT alongwith Salient Technical Features shall be, henceforth, published on the NTPC's website www.ntpc tender.com, Central Public Procurement Portal (CPPP) at www.eprocure.gov.in and Government E-Marketplace (GeM) portal of Govt. of India.
- 3.1 Nodal Executives identified from Contract & Materials Department at Corporate, Regions, Stations and Projects shall be responsible for forwarding the detailed NIT/IFB and Salient Technical Features to the agency managing the NTPC's website for publication of the same in the aforesaid websites. The Concerned Package-in-charge should ensure that the detailed NIT/IFB and Salient Technical Features are made available to the Nodal Executive at least three working days in advance as of the date of expected date of publication.
- 3.2 The above shall also be applicable for inviting proposals for enlistment of bidders / pre-qualification of bidders.
- 3.3 Notification regarding dis-continuation of publication of NIT / IFB in newspapers in future tenders is being issued in the leading newspapers.
- 3.4 Publication of Expression of Interest (EOI) may be done through newspapers, as per existing practice, as the same is published for gathering detailed information for the new type of packages. The same may be done with the approval of concerned Director / ED.
- 4.0 This issues with the approval of Competent Authority and shall come into force with immediate effect.
