And (3) The developed application / Website should be active including basic attributes as per the specification of the submitted Purchase Order for at least one year prior to the last date of submission of application.
6	DOCUMENT TO BE SUBMITTED BY VENDOR IN SUPPORT OF MEETING QR	(1) The certificate(s) issued by the concerned statutory authority / competent certification body. (2) Copies of the relevant PO(s) and Client's Completion Certificate or RA bill/GST Invoices/Final Deviation Statement certified by the concerned client.
7	Additional Documents to be submitted	In addition to the documents required in support of meeting technical requirements as stated above, following documents are required to be submitted by the Applicants applying for enlistment: - 1. Three POs with BOQs of the highest executed values of similar works during previous five years from the last date of submission of application and Copy of Completion Certificate from the concerned client /RA Bill/ GST Invoices in support of successful execution of works against each of the POs to be submitted. 2. Audited balance sheet including Profit & Loss statement for the previous three completed financial years reckoned from the last date of submission of application. In case the audited documents are not ready / available / applicable, then a certificate would be required from the CEO/CFO as per the format enclosed in the NIA documents

		stating that the financial results of the Company are under audit as on the date of submission of application and the financial parameters are not available. 3. Udyam / NSIC registration certificate, if applicable 4. PF and Service Tax registration certificate 5. Any other documents in addition to the above which the applicant wants to submit. 6.NTPC can ask for more documents if felt necessary. Also, all documents/ facilities can be verified/ assessed if required.
8	Notes	1. Similar Works: Similar Works means the criterion mentioned in Technical QR at Sl.-5 above. Maximum Three Credential Order(s) / Similar Work(s) shall be considered for calculation of the Execution Capability (EC). 2. The executed value means Basic value of quantity of similar works executed/supplied against the reference PO (also applicable to partly executed POs as on date of application). Where PO value is composite (i.e., including Taxes etc.), the applicant should give item-wise break-up of Composite PO value mentioning Basic Value, Taxes etc. 3. The work “executed” means the applicant should have achieved the criterion specified in the QR, even if the total contract is not completed/closed. In the case of contracts under execution as on the last date of submission of application for enlistment, the value of work executed till the last date of submission of application will be considered provided the same is certified by the employer. 4. In case, the executed reference works under two orders-- one for the supply and one for the services separately for the same installation / Development & Maintenance, combined value of both the orders shall be considered as a single order for the purpose of evaluation. 5. Reference work executed by the applicant as a subcontractor may also be considered provided the certificate issued by main contractor is duly certified by the owner specifying the scope of work executed by the sub-contractor in support of qualifying requirements.
