This Bid provides for Trade Receivables Discounting System (TReDS) as Preferred mode of payment. For MSME sellers, payments may be processed through a TReDS exchange in which the Buyer is registered, subject to applicable policy and regulatory guidelines. Accordingly, sellers intending to avail payment through TReDS are required to be registered with at least one TReDS exchange in which the buyer is registered.

1. Bid reserved for Make In India products: : Procurement under this bid is reserved for purchase from Class 1 local supplier as defined in public procurement (Preference to Make in India), Order 2017 as amended from time to time and its subsequent Orders/Notifications issued by concerned Nodal Ministry for specific Goods/Products. However, eligible micro and small enterprises will be allowed to participate. The minimum local content to qualify as a class 1 local supplier is denoted in the bid document. All bidders must upload a certificate from the OEM regarding the percentage of the local content and the details of locations at which the local value addition is made along with their bid, failing which the bid is liable to be rejected. In case the bid value is more than Rs 10 Crore, the declaration relating to percentage of local content shall be certified by the statutory auditor or cost auditor, if the OEM is a company and by a practicing cost accountant or a chartered accountant for OEMs other than companies as per the Public Procurement (preference to Make-in -India) order 2017 dated 04.06.2020 . In case Buyer has selected Purchase preference to Micro and Small Enterprises clause in the bid, the same will get precedence over this clause.

2. **Purchase preference to Micro and Small Enterprises (MSEs):** Purchase preference will be given to MSEs having valid Udyam Certificate and whose credentials are validated online through Udyam Registration portal as defined in Public Procurement Policy for Micro and Small Enterprises (MSEs) Order, 2012 dated 23.03.2012 issued by Ministry of Micro, Small and Medium Enterprises and its subsequent Orders/Notifications issued by concerned Ministry. If the bidder wants to avail themselves of the Purchase preference, the bidder must be the manufacturer / OEM of the offered product on GeM. In respect of bid for Services, the bidder must be the Service provider of the offered Service. Traders are excluded from the purview of Public Procurement Policy for Micro and Small Enterprises and hence resellers offering products manufactured by some other OEM are not eligible for any purchase preference. Relevant documentary evidence in this regard shall be uploaded along with the bid in respect of the offered product or service, and Buyer will decide eligibility for purchase preference based on documentary evidence submitted in case of product bids, whereas in case of services the eligibility is automatically validated. If L-1 is not an MSE and MSE Seller (s) has / have quoted price within $L-1+ 15\%$ (Selected by Buyer) of margin of purchase preference /price band defined in relevant policy, such MSE Seller shall be given opportunity to match L-1 price and contract will be awarded for 100% (selected by Buyer) percentage of total quantity. The buyers are advised to refer the [OM_No.1 4 2021_PPD dated 18.05.2023](#) for compliance of Concurrent application of Public Procurement Policy for Micro and Small Enterprises Order, 2012 and Public Procurement (Preference to Make in India) Order, 2017. Benefits of MSE will be allowed only if seller is validated on-line in GeM profile as well as validated and approved by Buyer after evaluation of documents submitted.

3. Estimated Bid Value indicated above is being declared solely for the purpose of guidance on EMD amount and for determining the Eligibility Criteria related to Turn Over, Past Performance and Project / Past Experience etc. This has no relevance or bearing on the price to be quoted by the bidders and is also not going to have any impact on bid participation. Also this is not going to be used as a criteria in determining reasonableness of quoted prices which would be determined by the buyer based on its own assessment of reasonableness and based on competitive prices received in Bid / RA process.

1.0 Qualifying Requirements:

The bidder who wishes to participate in the bidding shall meet the Qualifying Requirements stipulated hereunder:

1.1 Technical Criteria:

1.1.1 The bidder should be a Manufacturer of 'Wheel Loader/Pay Loader' or 'authorized Dealer / Distributor' of manufacturer for the same.

1.1.2 The bidder must have successfully executed orders for the supply of at least four (4) Wheel Loaders during the preceding seven (7) years prior to the date of the Techno-Commercial bid opening.

NOTES:

1.The word “executed” means the bidder should have achieved the criterion specified in the Qualifying Requirements, even if the Order is not completed/closed.

2.The dealer/distributor should be especially authorized by the manufacturer for participating in this bid.

3.Latest annual report OR NSIC / SSI / MSME registration certificate / BIS license / ISO certificate /M DCC/ any other statutory document as a proof of being manufacturer as per QR.

1.2. Financial Criteria:

1.2.1 Financial Criteria for the Bidder

The average annual turnover (AATO) of the Bidder on standalone basis, in the preceding three (3) completed financial years as on the date of Techno-commercial bid opening should be as per table ‘A’.

In case the Bidder does not satisfy the annual turnover criteria, stipulated above on its own, its Holding Company would be required to meet the stipulated turnover requirements as above, provided that the Net Worth of such Holding Company as on the last day of the preceding financial year is at least equal to or more than the paid- up share capital of the Holding Company. In such an event, the Bidder would be required to furnish along with its Techno-Commercial bid, a Letter of Undertaking from the Holding Company, supported by the Holding Company's Board Resolution, as per the format enclosed in the bid documents, pledging unconditional and irrevocable financial support for the execution of the Contract by the Bidder in case of award.

In case the Bidder is not able to furnish its audited financial statements on stand-alone entity basis, the unaudited unconsolidated financial statements of the Bidder can be considered acceptable provided the Bidder furnishes the following documents for substantiation of its qualification.

(i) Copies of the unaudited unconsolidated financial statements of the Bidder along with copies of the audited consolidated financial statements of its Holding Company.

(ii) A Certificate from the CEO/CFO of the Holding Company, as per the format enclosed in the bid documents, stating that the unaudited unconsolidated financial statements form part of the Consolidated Annual Financial Statements of the company.

In cases where audited results for the last financial year as on the date of Techno Commercial bid opening are not available, the financial results certified by a practicing Chartered Accountant shall be considered acceptable. In case, Bidder is not able to submit the Certificate from a practicing Chartered Accountant certifying its financial parameters, the audited results of three consecutive financial years preceding the last financial year shall be considered for evaluating the financial parameters. Further, a Certificate would be required from the CEO/CFO as per the format enclosed in the bidding documents stating that the financial results of the Company are under audit as on the date of techno-commercial bid opening and the Certificate from the practicing Chartered Accountant certifying the financial parameters is not available.

Notes for 1.2

(i)(a) In case of a Company, "Net Worth" means the sum total of the paid-up share capital and free reserves. "Free reserves" means all reserves credited out of the profits and share premium account but does not include reserves credited out of the revaluation of the assets, write back of depreciation provision and amalgamation. Further any debit balance of Profit and Loss account and miscellaneous expenses to the extent not adjusted or written off, if any, shall be reduced from reserves and surplus.

(b) In case of sole proprietorship/partnership, "Net Worth" means the aggregate of the balances in the Capital Account and the Current Account, where the Current Account is maintained to record regular transactions such as drawings, share of profit, interest on capital and other owner/partner related adjustments. The aggregate of balances should be positive.

(ii) Annual turnover shall mean Revenue from Operations of standalone Financial Statements of the Bidder and other income shall not be considered for arriving at annual turnover. While working out annual turnover of a bidder for the purpose of QR during bid evaluation, Taxes & Duties separately indicated (if any), in the Profit & Loss account shall not be considered.

(iii) For annual Turnover indicated in foreign currency, exchange rate as on seven (7) days prior to the Techno-Commercial bid opening shall be used.

(iv) "Holding Company" and "Subsidiary Company" shall have the meaning ascribed to them as per Companies Act 2013, as amended from time to time.

(v) If a bidder is not required to get its accounts audited under section 44AB of the Income Tax Act, 1961, the financial statements duly certified by a practicing Chartered Accountant shall be considered acceptable along with a certificate from chartered Accountant that bidder is not liable for audit under section 44AB.

(vi) In case a bidder meets the technical QR but could not furnish his / their audited financial statement of last three financial years for evaluating the average Annual turnover, due to the incorporation / formation of the bidder, within a period of less than 3 years from the original scheduled date of tender opening, then, such bidder shall also be considered and the Average annual turnover of such bidder shall be arrived at as below:

a. If such bidder furnishes audited financial statements for the last financial year only, then such bidder's average Annual turnover shall be arrived at by dividing the Turnover of the last financial year by 1.5.

b. If such bidder furnishes audited financial statements for the last two financial years only, then the bidder's average Annual turnover shall be arrived at by dividing the sum of Turnover of last two fi

nancial years by 2.5.
